## St. Charles Parish School Students Observe Lent With Meaningful Activities

Students are sacrificing recess time, foregoing snack periods and spending time in class taking part in the 1 % Prayer Challenge during the first few weeks of Lent. Many classes voted on ways they could have a meaningful Lent and in more than one case it came back to giving up things they enjoy most: recess and snack.

In 4th Grade, rather than run around at 2 pm recess, students have the option of working on their Lenten booklet, writing in their Stations of the Cross journal, praying the rosary, reading a favorite Bible passage, reading from their religion book or using that time for silent prayer. They also continue to watch and discuss the "Best Lent Ever" video series by Matthew Kelly.

In 5th Grade, students read Scripture passages and then go to a comfortable spot in the room to pray. The kids also write reflections on the Scripture.

### In other school news:

A round of applause for 1st Grade students who did a great job on their recent Animal Science Fair Projects. Where else could you learn about coyotes, bald eagles, snow owls and cheetahs, among other animals, from such sweet-faced children?

The students were in charge of researching animals and their habitats, typing up the report, creating a diorama and finally presenting what they learned to other parents and guests. Great practice for middle school when the heavy-duty Science Fair Projects come into play.
