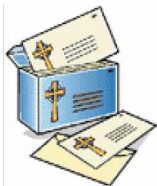

## Inspire Others to Participate in Abuse Prevention

You can help create a safer environment for children by inspiring others to participate in your community's abuse prevention efforts. If you focus on the baby steps – in this case, identifying and inviting one person per week to get involved in preventing abuse – during the next 12 months you could realistically recruit more than four dozen people to your community's abuse prevention efforts.
