

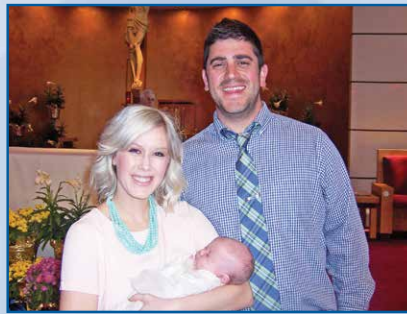

Baptism of Infants and Children

Parents will then contact Beth Thompson at 262-367-6704 to schedule a date for their child's baptism. Baptisms are celebrated at St. Charles on Sundays of every month except during Lent and Advent.
