Baptism of Infants and Children

Parents who wish to have their child baptized should contact the Parish Office at 262-367-0800. Parents will then contact Beth Thompson at 262-367-6704 to schedule a date for their child's baptism. Baptisms are celebrated at St. Charles on Sundays of every month except during Lent and Advent.

The Most Holy Trinity

St. Charles Graduates Earn Prestigious Awards

Congratulations to the 21 graduates from St. Charles Parish School. In the fall, five graduates will study at Marquette University High School, seven more will attend Catholic Memorial High School, eight graduates will attend Arrowhead and one heads to Pewaukee High School.

Kudos to the students who won top awards this year:

* Bobby Henkel Award, given to students who exhibit athleticism and courage and sportsmanship on and off the court: **Brad Alexander and Nick Tianyik**

* Krystina Finn Award, a new award named for the St. Charles Parish School alum who lost her battle with cancer in 2014. She lived her life as a model of service to others. This inaugural award was given to **Elisa Keefner**.

* The American Citizenship Award recognizes a student's participation in service to the school and the community: **Logan Gehring**

* The Christian Witness Award recognizes a student who is a model of Christ and who demonstrates Christ-like behavior to fellow students and adults: **Connor Murphy**

* Catholic Scholarship Essay: Each year St. Charles provides a scholarship to a graduate who will attend a Catholic High School. Students wrote an essay on how they will take their faith forward to high school. Scholarship winners are **JJ Mei**, who will attend Catholic Memorial, and **Eric Olson**, who will attend Marquette University High School.

* Borromeo Award, recognizes a student who has demonstrated outstanding Christian character, academic excellence and the ability to lead by example. This award is for the student who combines these qualities to best represent St. Charles Parish School: **Patrick Merkel**.

* Rose and Louis Scrima Scholarship from Catholic Memorial High School is awarded to one incoming freshman each year. To be a finalist students must take the CMH placement test. This year more than 160 students from across the Archdiocese of Milwaukee took the placement test and the top 11 students were chosen as finalists. The final step of the scholarship competition is a panel interview, focusing on faith, service and leadership. This year the Scrima Scholarship, a \$1,500 renewable four-year scholarship, was awarded to **Renata Holmes**. On a separate note **Renata** also won 2nd place in the state of Wisconsin for the Modern Woodsmen Speech Contest. The topic of the speech was heroes.
