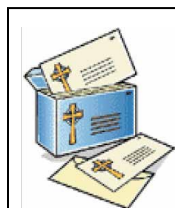

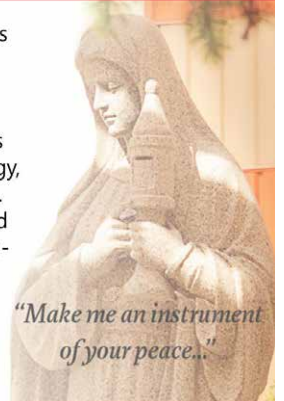
Vacation Bible School
