The Transfiguration of the Lord Gospel Reflection

"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." Oh, to be on that mountain! What a priceless experience for Peter, James, and John. If they had ever doubted, if they wondered whether Jesus was really who he said he was, their confidence surely got a boost on the day of the Transfiguration. Before their very eyes, Jesus' divine beauty radiated gloriously while the two ancient prophets also appeared in miraculous manner. And to top it off, the voice of God the Father spoke from the heavens and confirmed that it was all true: Jesus really is the Son of God!

Why did Jesus reveal himself in such a remarkable way to these men? Perhaps we have an answer in today's epistle. Peter writes, "We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven while we were with him on the holy mountain." Peter mentions this fact in order to confirm his credibility as a preacher as he goes on to say, "We possess the prophetic message that is altogether reliable. You will do well to be attentive to it." Because of the mission that Peter had to help shape and nurture the Church in its earliest days, his position as an "eyewitness" to the Transfiguration helped to gain the attention, and the faith, of his hearers.

So although we were not there during this holy apparition, we have the benefit of it. We have heard the testimony that Jesus is truly our God from those who saw in person that it was for real. In this way, the Transfiguration is able to bolster the faith of many, not just the three men who were there that day. May we have the grace to allow the feast we celebrate today to truly deepen our faith.

## School Supplies Badly Needed

Hello St. Charles Parishioners,

My name is Deacon Allen Olson and until this June I was the Middle School Religion and kindergarten through 8th Grade Music teacher at St. Charles Parish School.

I'm also a Deacon and the soon-to-be Pastoral Associate at Saint Teresa of Calcutta Church in North Lake.

Every December parishioner Jacyntha Shaw, and I travel to the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota.

Pine Ridge is the poorest Indian Reservation in the United States. The reservation includes Red Cloud Catholic School which has wonderful connections with Marquette Jesuits. Through the generous donations of St. Charles Parish and School we are able to give each teacher in kindergarten through 8th Grade a box of teaching supplies. In addition, each student receives a bag of school supplies such with pens, pencils, paper, crayons/markers, just to name a few.

We also give each student in kindergarten through 4th Grade a small stuffed animal that will be given to that child at Christmas. For many, this is the only gift they he or she will receive at Christmas.

We deliver clothing (new) for Sacred Heart (which is similar to St. Vincent de Paul) and residents may purchase the clothing at extremely low prices.

Through the generous donations of St. Charles parishioners we also supply another nearby Catholic school on the reservation, Our Lady of Lourdes, with the same amount of supplies as Red Cloud Catholic School.

Once again, I humbly ask for your generosity. As you purchase school supplies for your children would you please also purchase an item for Red Cloud school students? You will make these children extremely happy.

There are large totes at the back of the church where you may drop off the school items.
