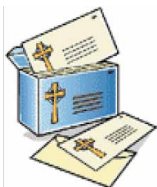

## Help Support Catholic School Students on South Dakota Indian Reservation

Each year Deacon Allen Olson, the soon-to-be Pastoral Associate at St. Teresa of Calcutta Church in North Lake and former Middle School Religion and kindergarten through 8th Grade Music teacher at St. Charles Parish School, and parishioner Jacyntha Shaw, travel to the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota. Pine Ridge is the poorest Indian Reservation in the United States.

Through the generous donations of parishioners/supporters from St. Charles Parish & School and St. Teresa each teacher in kindergarten through 8th Grade receives a box of teaching supplies. Each student receives a bag of school supplies.
