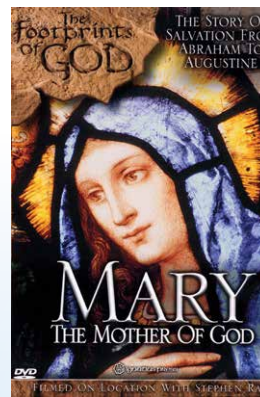

Our benefactors contribute the time and charity necessary to keep the SVdP food pantry serving the Hartland community. Have you wondered about its operation? Financial donations directed to the pantry are utilized by our food pantry manager to purchase needed items, pay the pantry's rent and utility payments. Food and miscellaneous items donated by parishioners, or from SVdP barrels at local stores, are transported to the pantry by members where each item's expiration date is checked; expired food must be discarded. Shelves are restocked to ensure product is available for patron shopping on Tuesdays.

Our patrons are treated with dignity and choose their own items, just as in a grocery store. Fresh produce is available in season, donated by generous local gardeners, St. Charles' SVdP, and other churches. Patrons are also able to select bread and bakery items that have been donated by local stores. Our SVdP food pantry volunteers pack patrons choices, often helping them carry their selections to their cars. At times, patrons who use the pantry express other needs such as clothing for their families, furniture, or mattresses.

Vouchers are issued to meet those needs, using monies donated to our general fund. Often, pantry patrons arrive seeking companionship or encouragement while carrying heavy crosses. SVdP volunteers are there. Our food pantry is for people and operates because of people - our generous hearted benefactors and volunteers.

FOOD PANTRY NEEDS: pancake mix, canned hams, jelly, Kleenex, laundry detergent, paper towel and toilet paper.

If you are in need of financial assistance, please contact SVdP at 262-367-0800. We also operate a food pantry located at 229 Lawn Street, Hartland. The pantry is open Tuesday mornings between 10 and noon. It is also open on the second and fourth Tuesday evenings of each month between 5:30 pm and 7 pm.

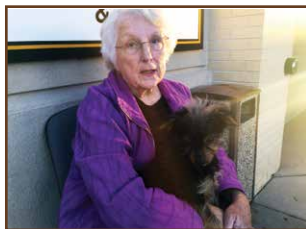
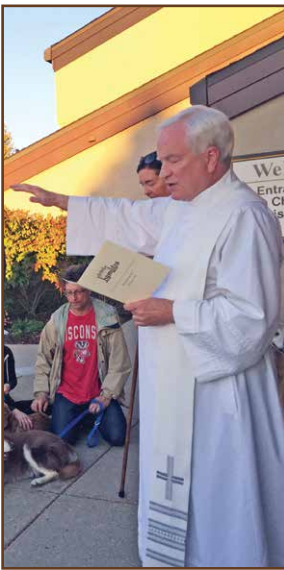
