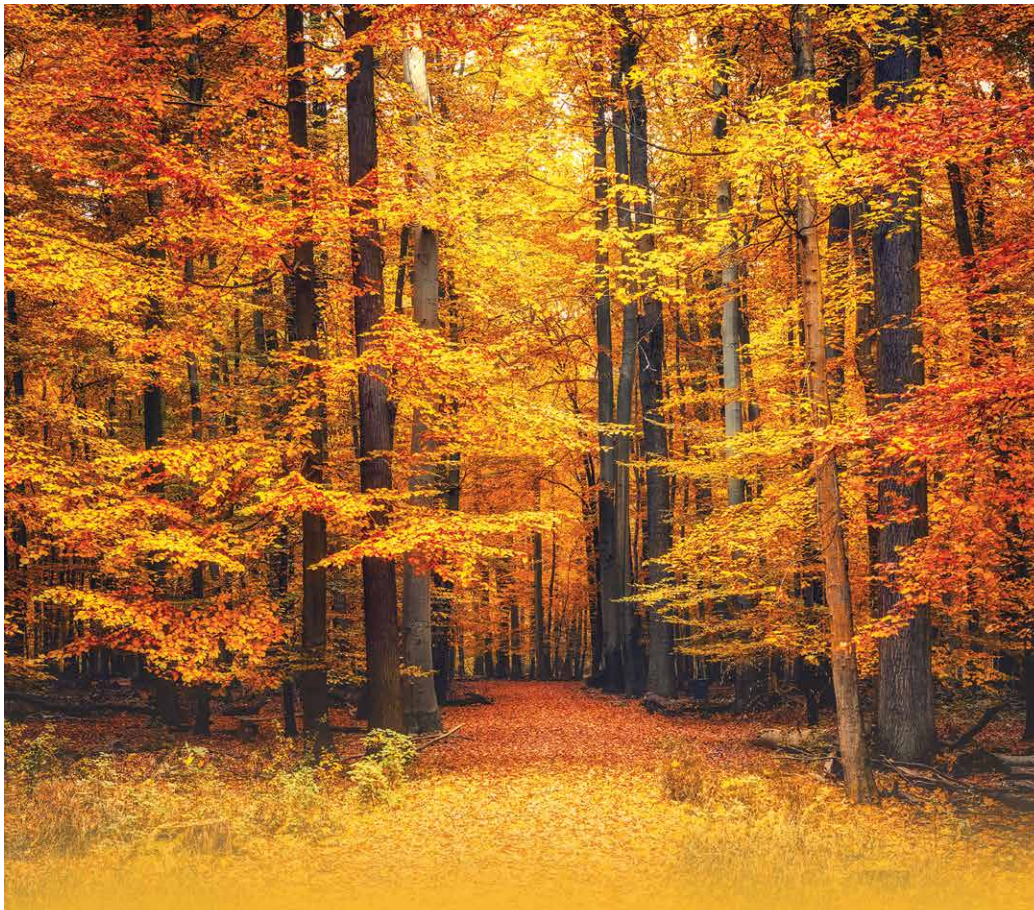

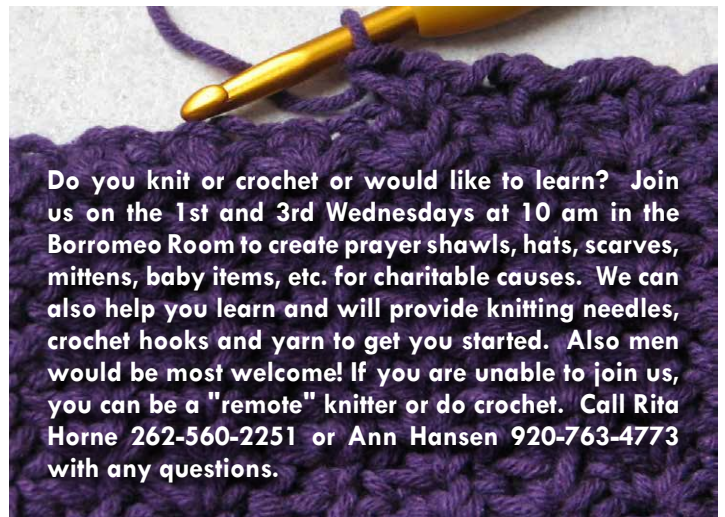
**Circle of Love**
