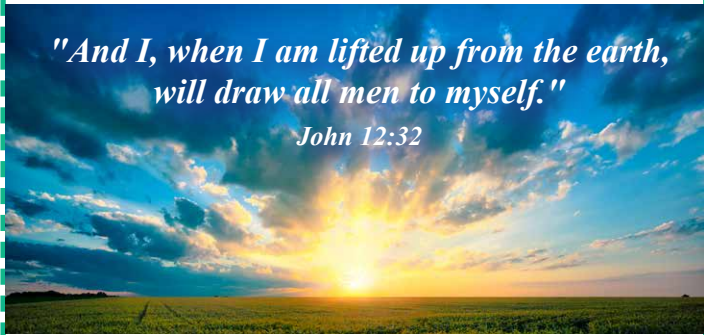

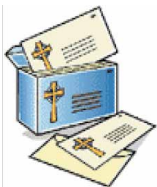

New Church Architectural Drawings Unveiled During May 17th Meeting

Please join us on Thursday, May 17 in the church as we present architectural plans for the new Roman Catholic Church at St. Charles.

Fr. Ken Omernick, Building Committee Chair Mike Berendes and members of the Building Expansion Committee will share with parishioners steps taken to design the traditional-looking worship space.

The Building Committee meets weekly to work on plans and members have also drawn inspiration from visits to a dozen churches in Wisconsin, Illinois and Indiana.

Architects Kurt Zimmerman and Doug Barnes from Zimmerman Architectural Studios will also be at the meeting to answer design questions.

The meeting begins at 7 pm. There will be time to ask questions about the project and to talk individually with Building Committee members.

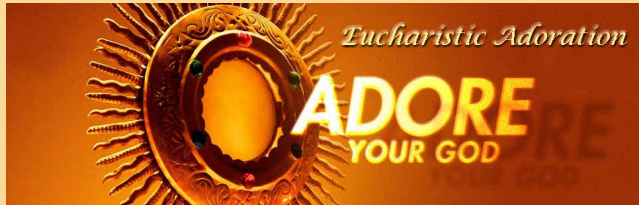
Child Formation Summer Registration is open for Grades 1, 3, 4, 5 and 6

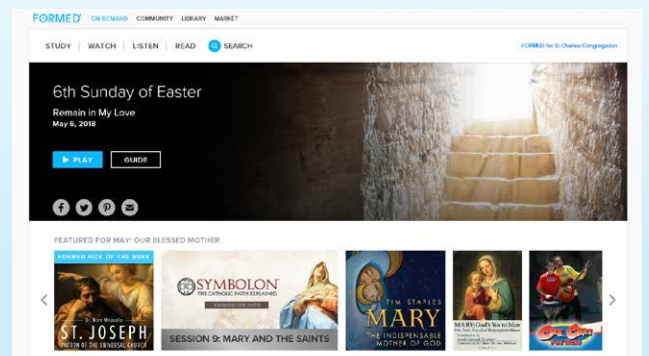

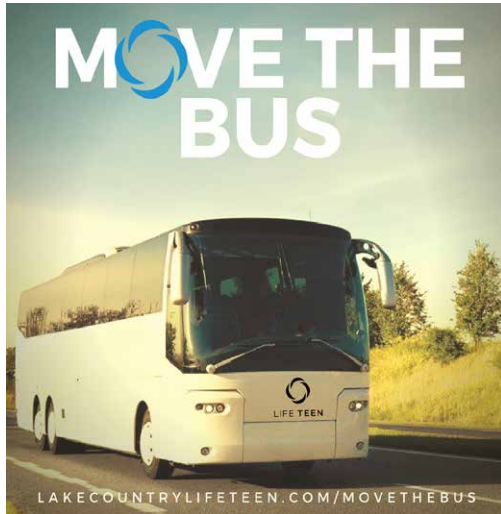
