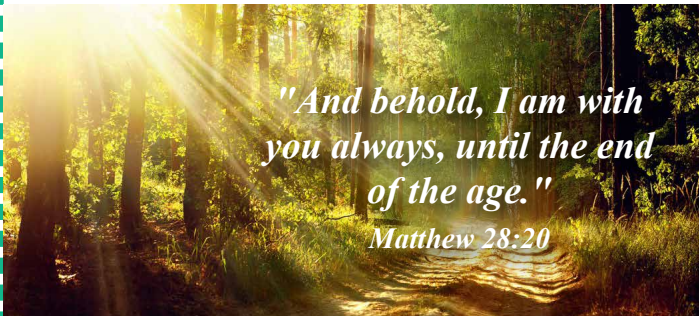

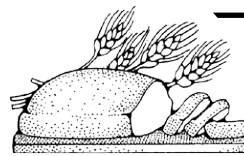
ST. VINCENT de PAUL SOCIETY
