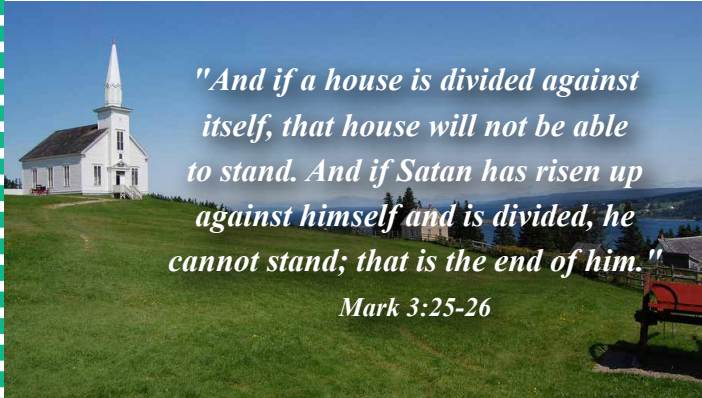

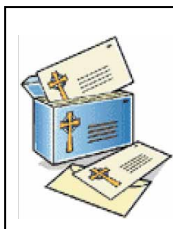

Support the St. Charles Parish School Annual Development Fund

St. Charles Parish School, which recently received a third Exemplary Recognition honor from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, ends the school year on June 7.

It's been a successful year on many fronts as we opened a new wing with two large and bright classrooms, a state-of-the-art STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) Lab, a long-awaited music room and a new concession stand.

Also this year enrollment rose to 300 students, double the enrollment from nine years ago and registrations for the 2018-2019 School Year are strong.

A total of 38 students graduated last week, the largest graduating class in recent years and a testament to the hard work taking place on all fronts.

The Annual Development Fund (ADF) is in full swing and donations are an important part of our school's sustained operations, growth and improvement. The school relies on the ADF to help bridge the gap between student tuition, the parish subsidy and the true cost to educate a child. Our school has one of the lowest tuition rates of all Catholic schools in the Western Waukesha Deanery.

The money donated last year to the ADF allowed for the hiring of 2.5 instructional aides who can assist in individual student needs such as math, reading and advanced curriculums and allows teachers to tailor the education to each student's needs.

Another major benefit from the ADF donations was hiring our new Guidance Counselor to help kids thrive socially, emotionally and mentally.

Our school's achievements are being recognized. In April St. Charles earned an Exemplary Recognition Award for Educating the Whole Student, the third exemplary honor in the last six years. St. Charles was the only school in Waukesha County to receive the award this year.
