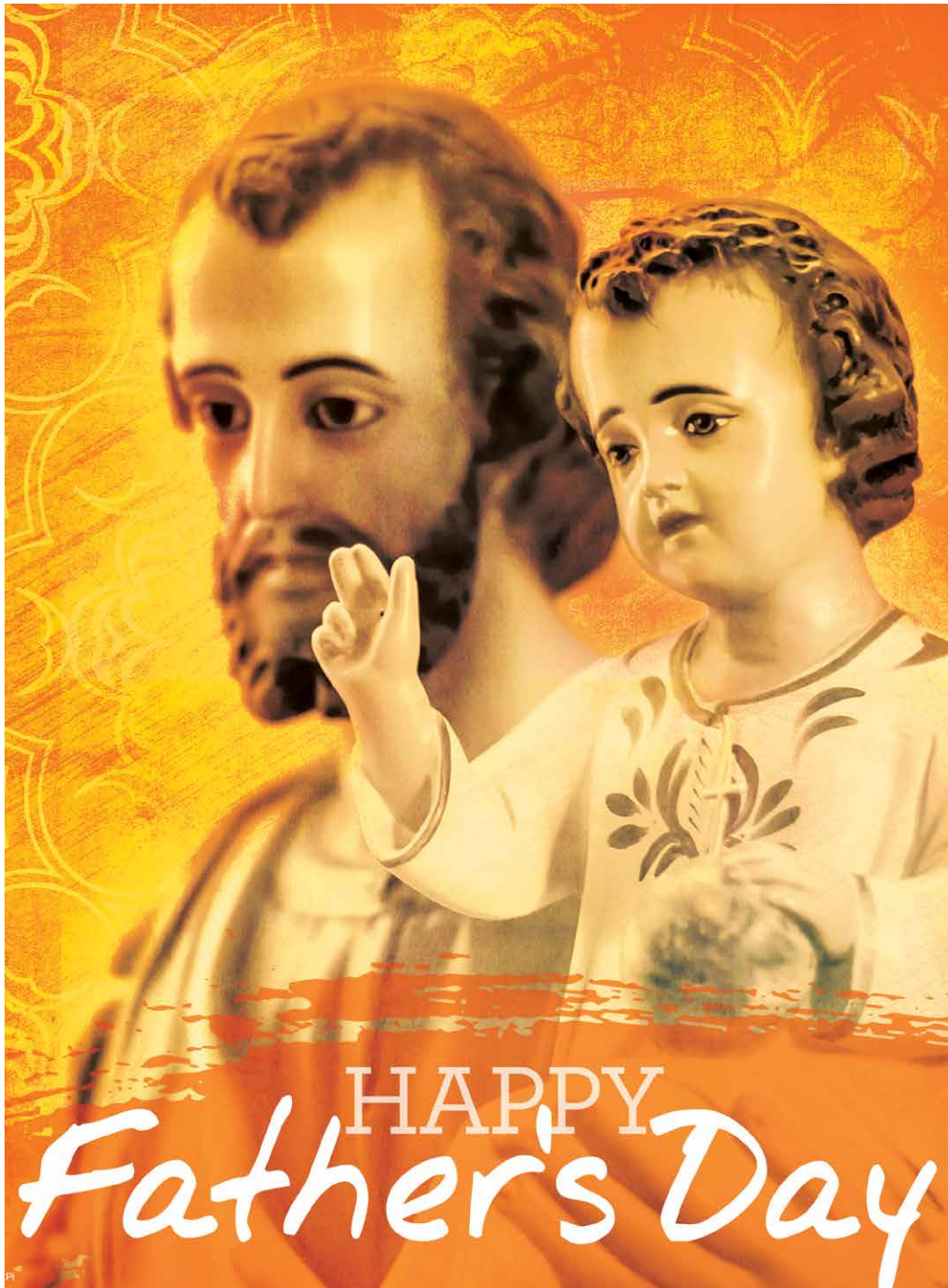

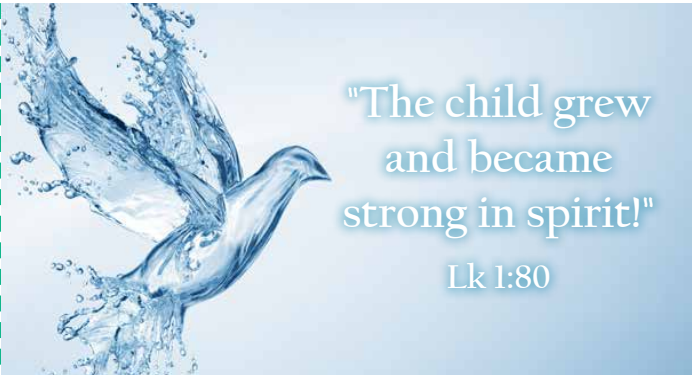

Pastoral Council Trustee-Treasurer**

Nominations for the Pastoral Council Trustee-Treasurer position are now being accepted.
