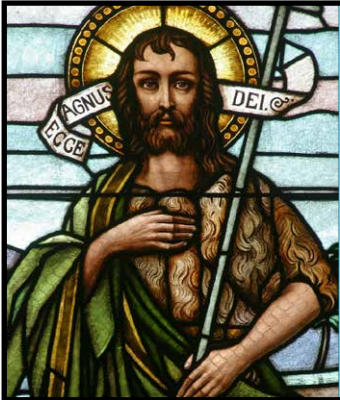

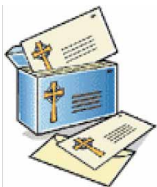

Applause for Graduating 8th Grade Class

American Citizenship Award
