- Listen to His answer to you and then respond by saying, "I believe the Lord wants me to ..."
- Ask the Lord for what you need to respond to His word. Thank Him for being with you today.
- Close with an Our Father. End in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

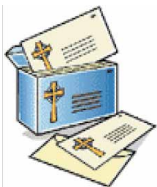

Food Pantry donations are down. At the same time, the numbers of hungry people in Hartland who need to use the pantry are growing. A total of 25 families used the food pantry the morning of June 26th, including several new patrons/families. Many more attended the evening session. When the pantry opened for business that morning, there was only 1 box of Kleenex and 9 bottles of liquid dish soap in stock that day. Patrons at the morning session collectively selected 25 rolls of paper towels and 100 rolls of toilet paper. Most patrons also chose laundry detergent, cereal, pasta sides, sugar, juice, canned fruit, and canned meat. Numerous other food and hygiene items also were chosen. We are so grateful for the generosity of St. Charles' parishioners and our benefactors. As a SVdP food pantry, we receive no government assistance or funding, relying strictly on kind hearts to keep the SVdP food pantry available for those who suffer lack in our community. Thank you for your benevolence and helping us help those in need.

FOOD PANTRY NEEDS: cooking oil, white sugar, powdered sugar, juice, canned pineapple, beef stew, canned hams, pancake syrup, spaghetti sauce, strawberry jelly, liquid dish soap and Kleenex.
