A Fond Farewell



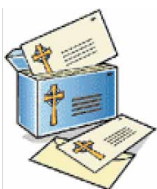

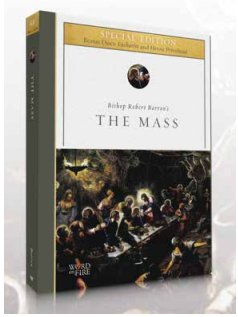


St. Charles Columbarium
