

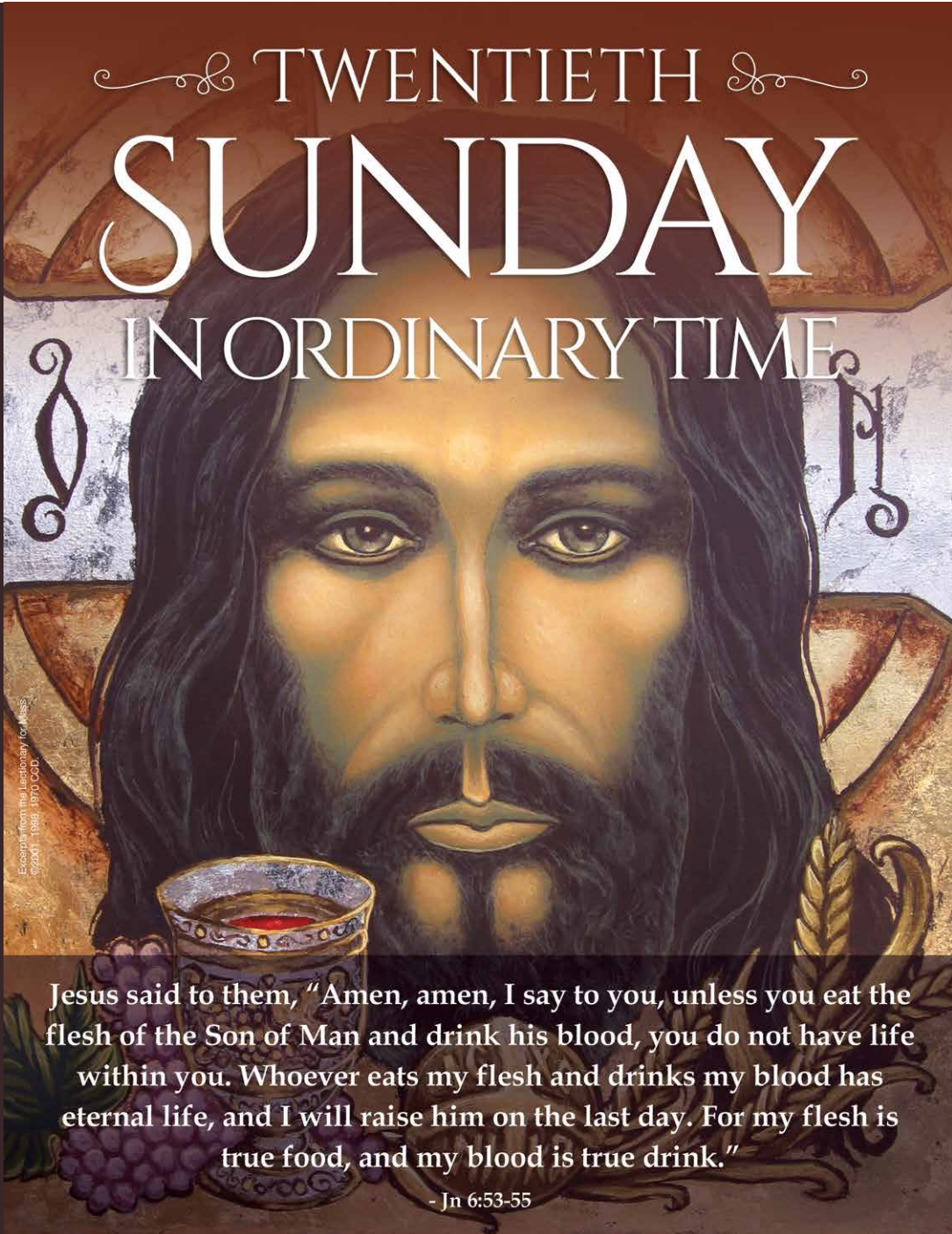

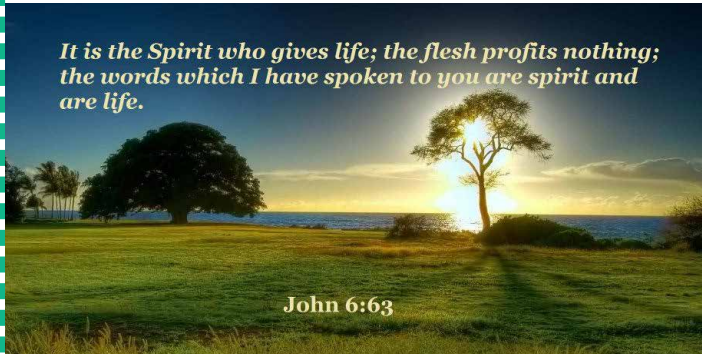

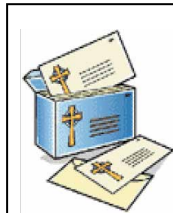

Calling All Student Chess Players

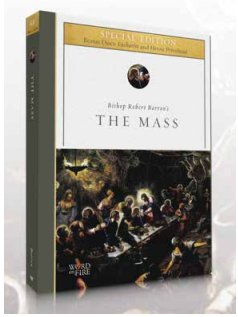
Do you love chess? Join our new St. Charles School Chess Team as we welcome players of all levels.

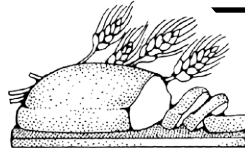
