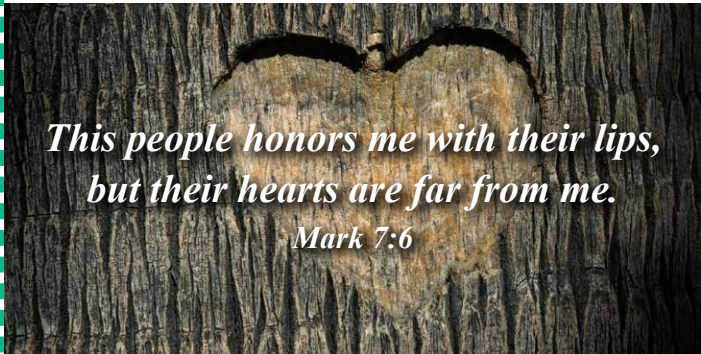

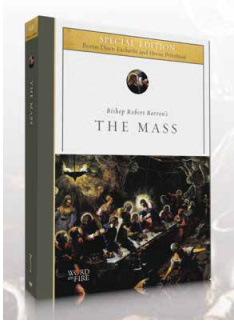

All parishioners, school families, family members and friends are welcome to the first All School Mass of the year on Friday, Aug. 31st at 8:30 am.

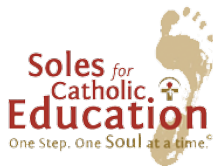

Our members have delivered meals to shut-ins, fed the homeless in Waukesha, packed and delivered 216 summer lunches to hungry children, comforted the sick, consoled the incarcerated, operated a food pantry, and visited patrons in their homes to assess and meet their needs. Additionally, back packs filled with school supplies and shoe certificates were provided to Hartland children living in poverty. In the past two weeks, through the benevolence of our donors, three patrons were provided a combined total of \$1400 in financial assistance. Poverty never rests, neither does the need for charitable acts. Please consider SVdP when making charitable bequests, memorials, or donations.
