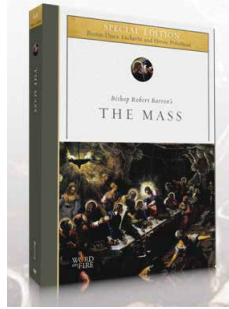

St. Charles Parish School Needs Your Box Tops!

Specifically your General Mills Box Tops for Education.

The Box Tops drive is a big fundraiser for the school and we receive money for each Box Top sent to General Mills. We're hoping our parishioners can help. Last year our school earned nearly \$1,400 from Box Tops.

1. Buy your favorite General Mills foods and products and make sure to clip the Box Top symbol on the box.
2. Drop off the Box Tops in the Parish Office or place them in the drop slot outside of the Parish Office if you come to church during hours when the office is closed. There are expiration dates for each Box Top so don't hang onto them too long. If the Box Top is expired we won't receive money.
3. We're in the midst of a big push for Box Tops as the next big deadline is the the end of October.
