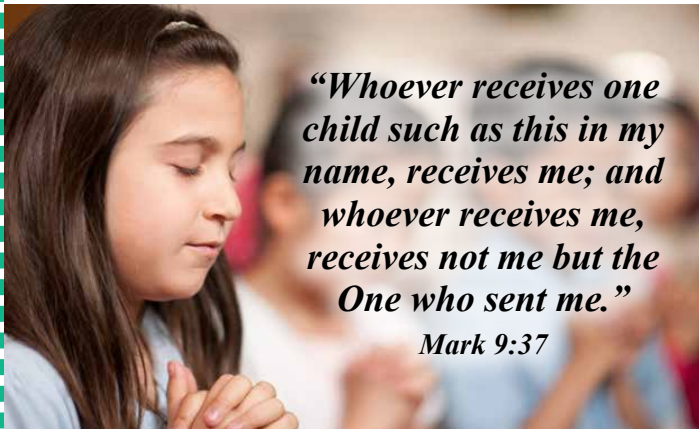

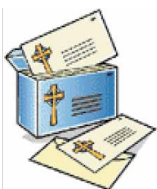

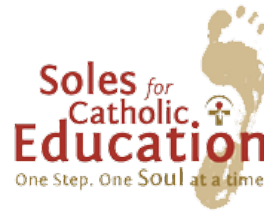
### Volunteer Opportunities
