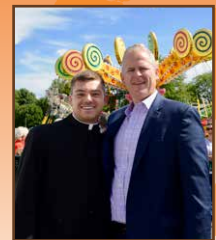

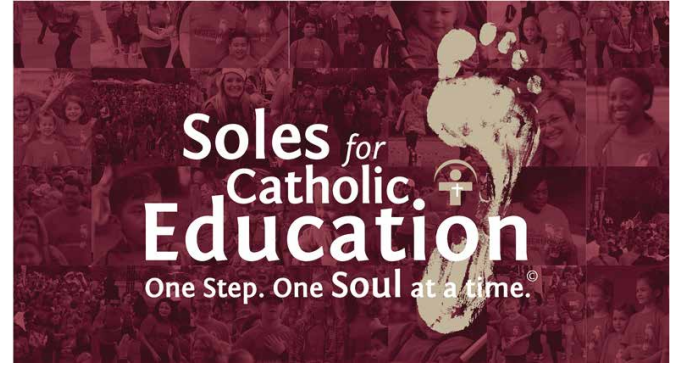

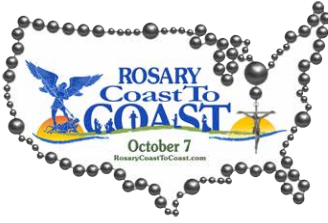
Last year, 222 supporters of Catholic education joined St. Charles at the Soles Walk. You can help us reach our goal of 300 walkers this year by registering now!
