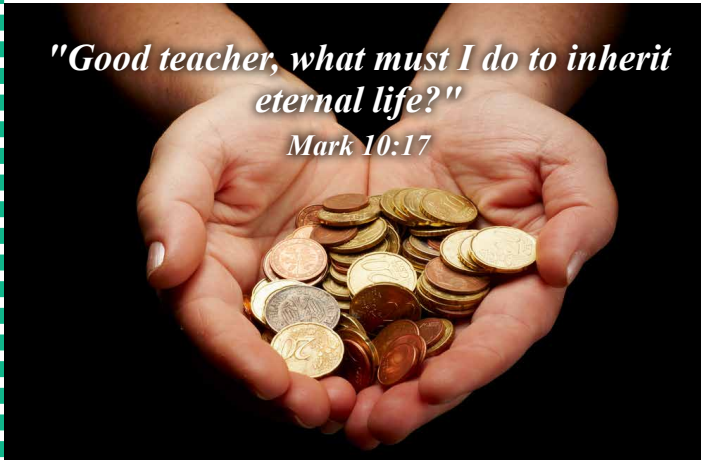

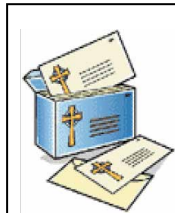

Your baby is ill, rent is due, and your hours were cut at work. To whom should you go? Your cupboards are nearly bare, your Social Security check (your only income) won't arrive for another week. To whom should you go? Your car won't start (again), utility payments are due and you know you'll be fired if you are late for work. To whom should you go? Our neighbors in need cry out for help. Is anyone listening? SVdP is here to help. Our members visit the needy in hospitals, nursing homes, jails and private homes to assess the needs of those who reach out to us. We offer comfort during times of trial, friendship when lonely and provide financial assistance such as aid with housing, medical bills, utility payments and auto repairs to those experiencing economic lack. If one is hungry, St. Charles SVdP operates a food pantry, participates in meal programs for the homeless and summer lunch programs for disadvantaged school children. 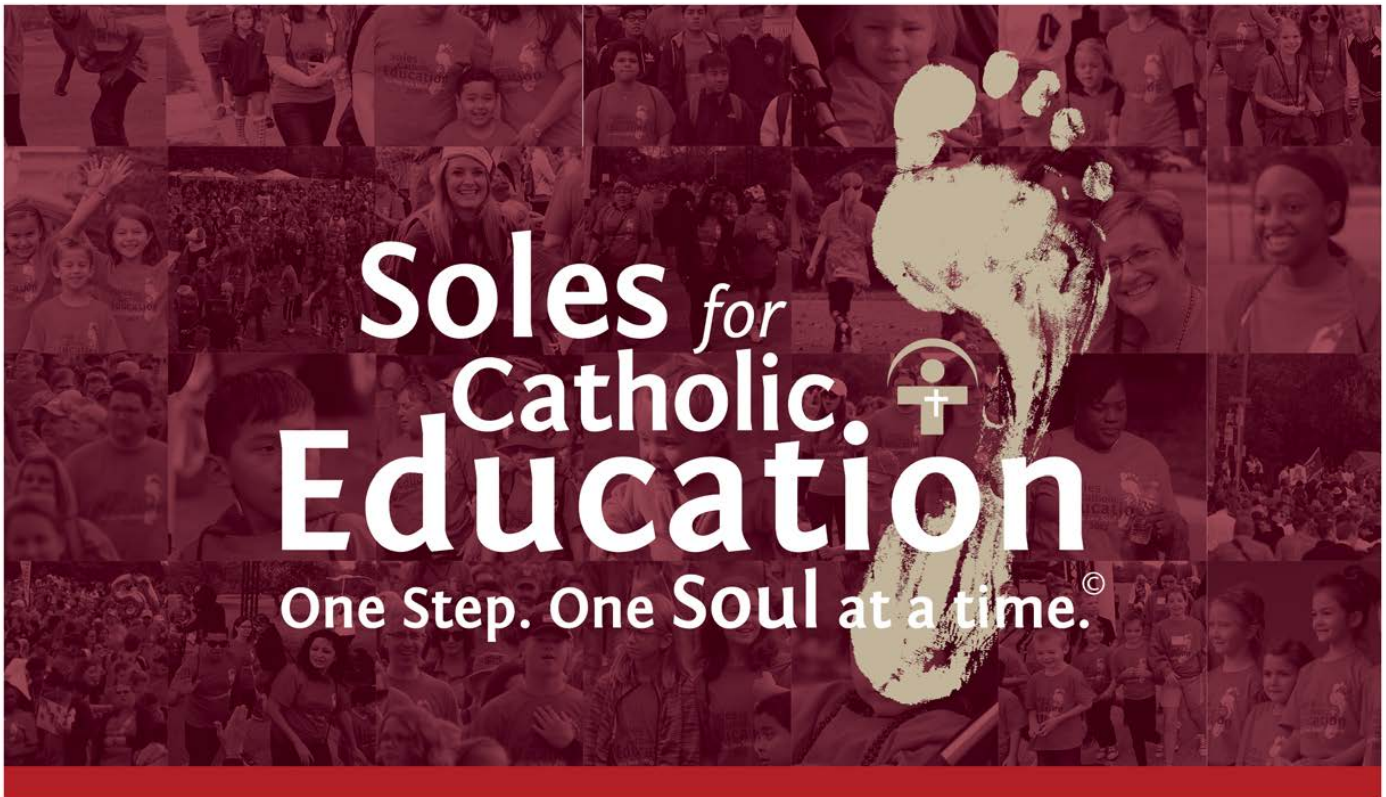
