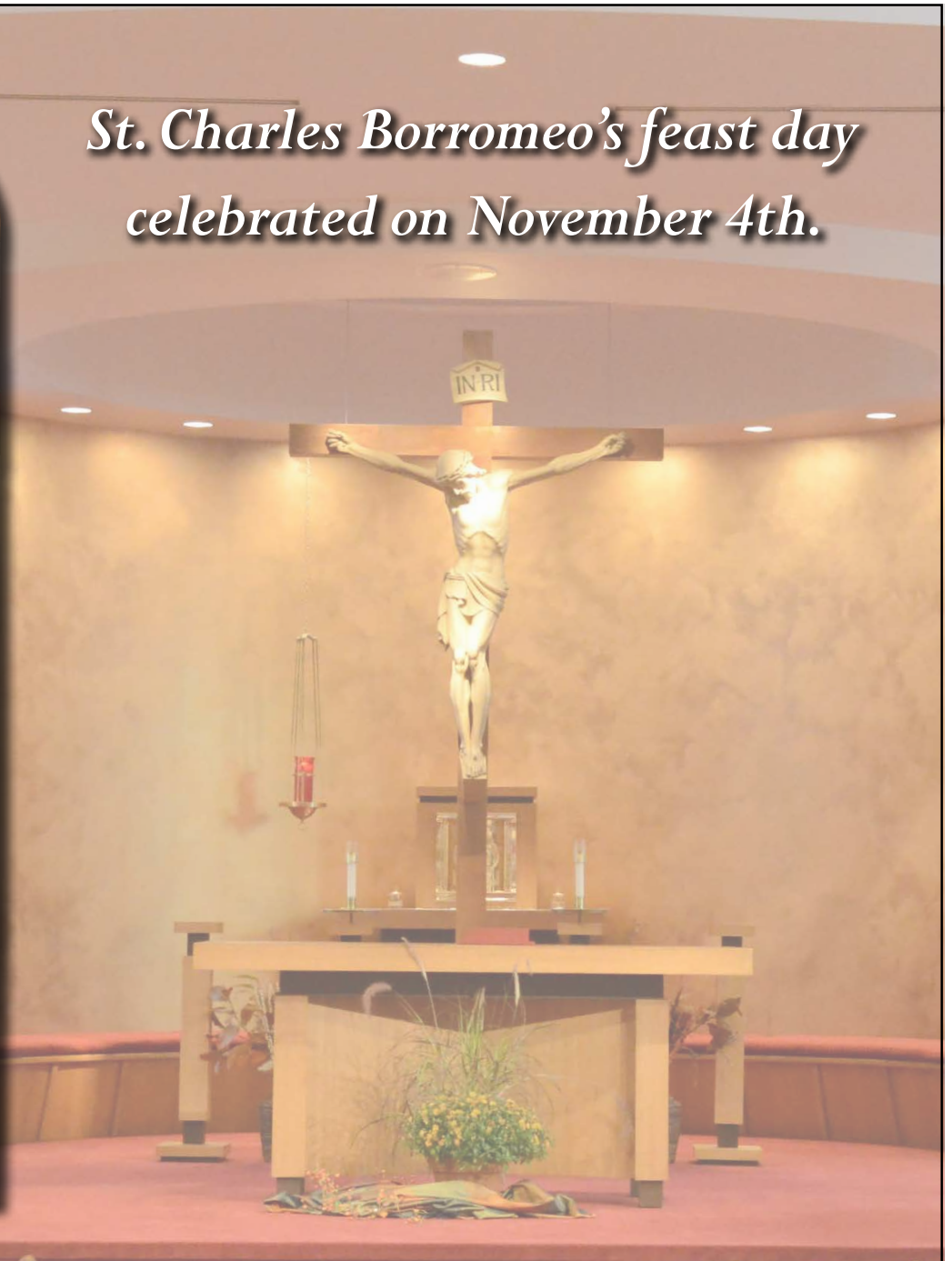

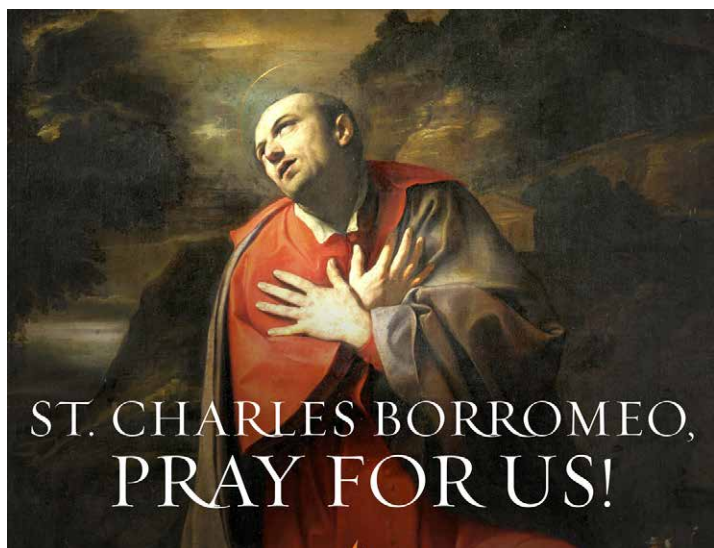

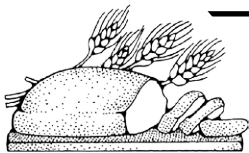

Our incarcerated brothers and sisters are released with the same clothing they wore upon arrival at the jail. During winter, release may be to snow covered streets clad only in shorts, tank tops, and flip flops if they arrived during summer months. The St. Dismas ministry strives to have warm coats and clothing always available especially if the person is released during hours when stores are closed. Our Lord tells us to not judge, lest we be judged, how can we allow another human being to face frigid temperatures unprepared if we have the means to help? To donate, please take your warm clothing to the Waukesha SVdP office located in the retail store building at 818 Sunset Drive, Waukesha. **You must label your donation for St. Dismas.** If you are not able to personally take your items to the store, please contact SVdP at 262-367-0800 for other arrangements.


2018 Bake Sales!
