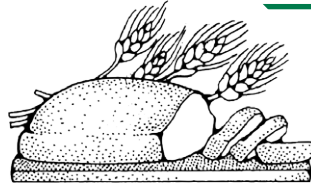

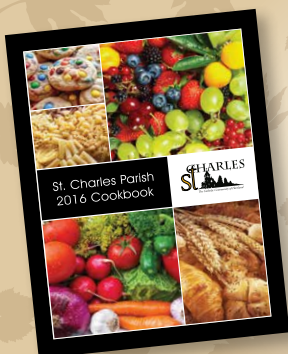
The Christmas Bake Sale will be held after all Masses on Dec. 15th & 16th.
