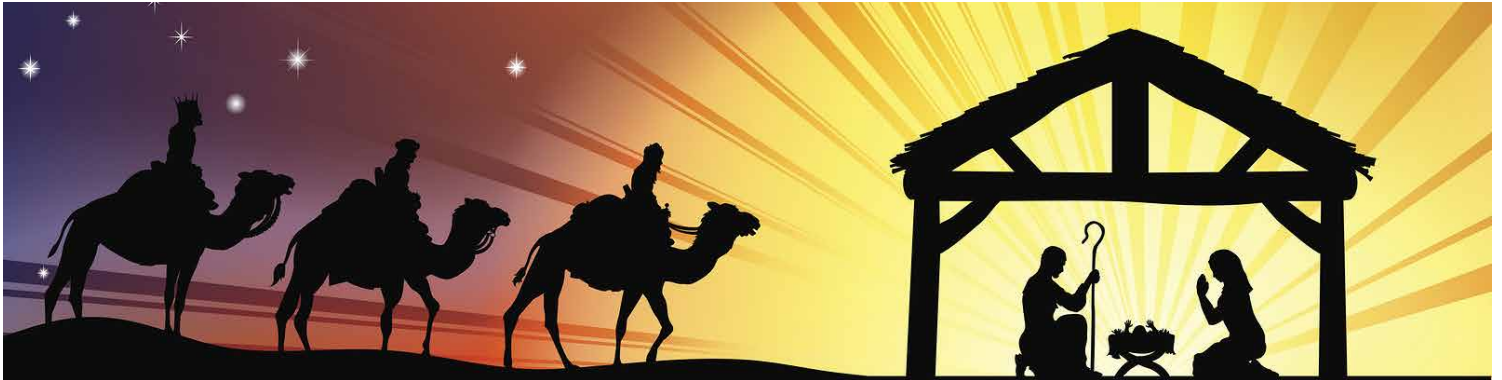

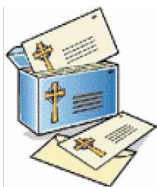

**POVERTY AWARENESS MONTH!** The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has proclaimed January as Poverty Awareness Month. The Catholic Church and its members respond to diverse forms of suffering throughout the world. Did you know that many of your neighbors in Hartland live below or near the poverty level and also need help to alleviate the want and stress they experience from economic lack? On Dec. 19th lines of needy families formed well before the food pantry opened and 43 families used the pantry that morning, feeding a total of 77 people. Have you wondered why our list of pantry needs repeat despite receiving donations? On that Tuesday, we distributed 43 rolls of paper towels, 43 boxes of Kleenex, 43 packs of toilet paper, along with mayonnaise, cereals, sugars, meats, soups, laundry detergent, personal hygiene items, and a myriad of other foods and necessities. Those same items were in need the following Tuesday morning and evening for a different group of patrons.

The pantry is able to remain open only through your benevolence. We would like to express our appreciation to all of our benefactors along with the schools and businesses who organized recent food drives. Your generosity supplied food, warm mittens and hats, meals, Christmas gifts and the financial means to pay rent, car repairs and other bills for many needy families who had been experiencing the coming of Christmas without hope. You brought those families the hope of Christ and His peace this Christmas.
