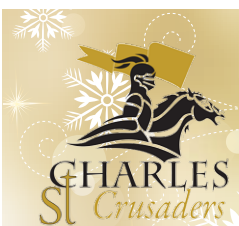

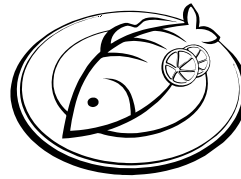
Please Bring In Last Year's Palms Now until Feb. 13th

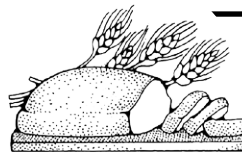

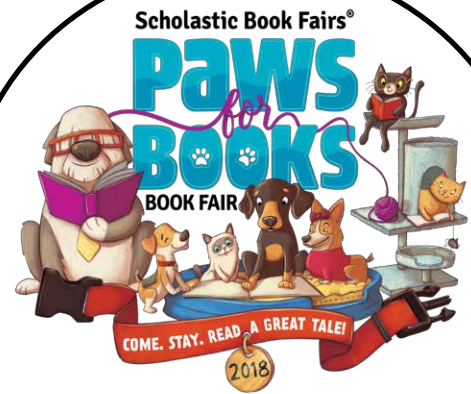
