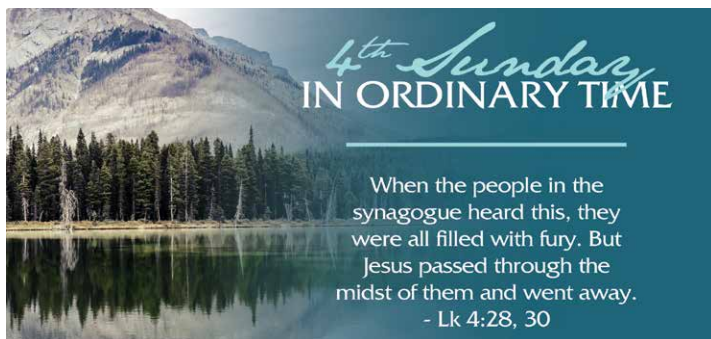

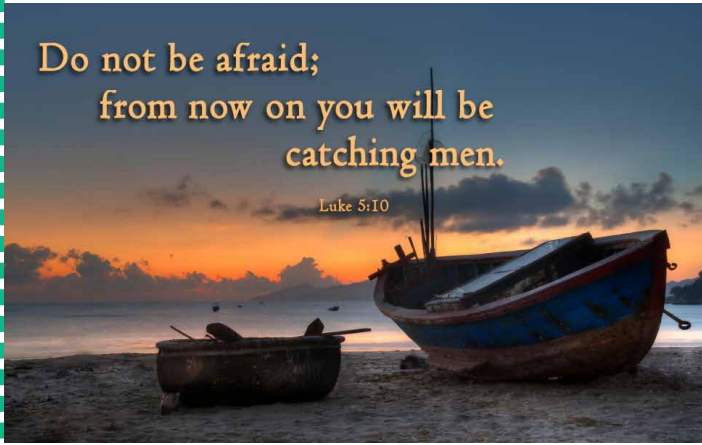

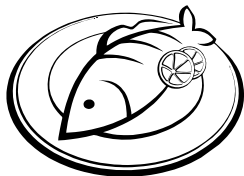

**Red Rosebud** – Celebrates birth and adoptions

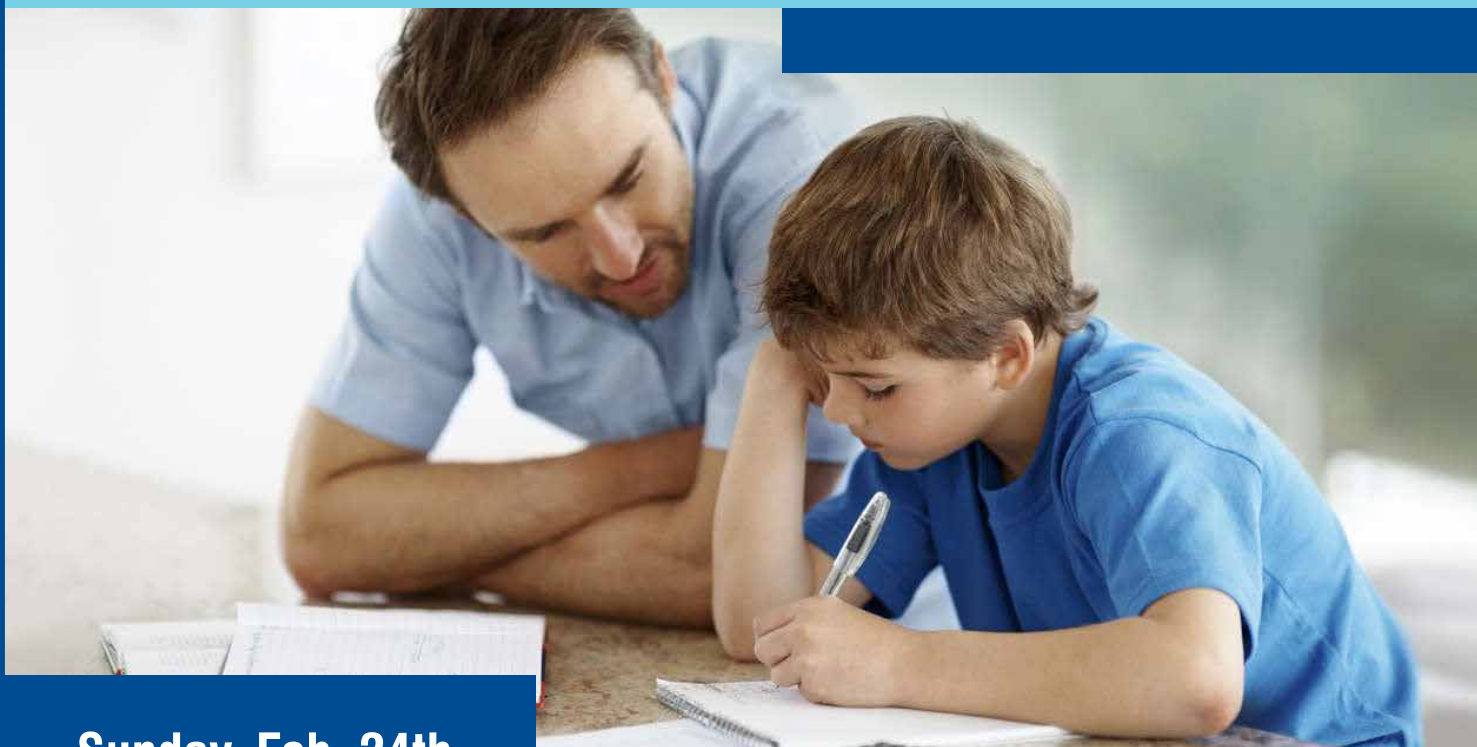
**White Rosebud** – Grieves with families suffering a miscarriage, abortion, stillbirth, infant or child death
