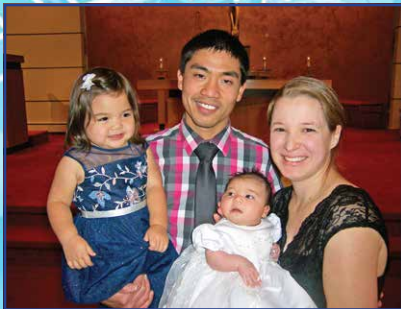

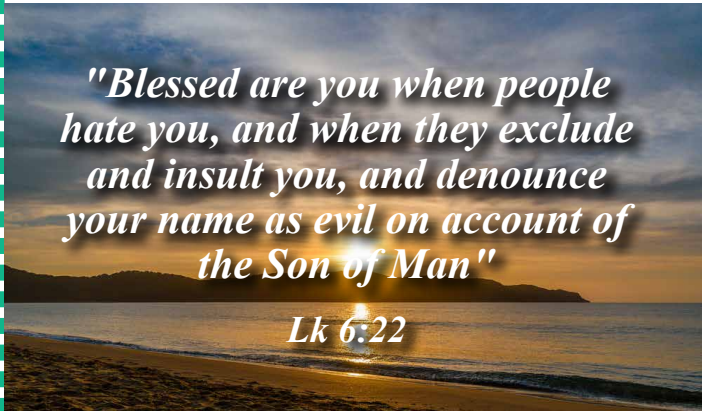

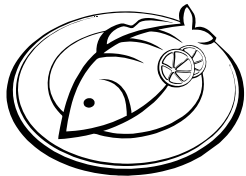

## Childhood Anxiety and the Role of a Parent

Educational Talk

All parents are invited to a talk about childhood anxiety by Dr. Jeffrey Karst, a pediatric psychologist at Children's Hospital of Wisconsin and Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at the Medical College of Wisconsin.
