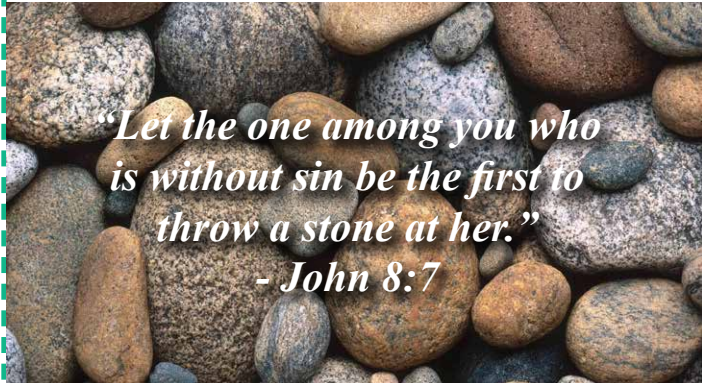

40 Hours Devotion

at St. Charles Parish



Beginning Friday, April 5th at 6:00 pm through Sunday, April 7th, 6:00 pm

The Forty Hours’ Devotion (in Latin, Quarantore) is an ancient tradition of the Church that St. Charles Parish wishes to reclaim during Lent. During this devotion, forty hours of continuous prayer is made before the Blessed Sacrament in solemn exposition.

Our Forty Hours Devotion will begin at 6 pm on Friday, April 5th with the Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and conclude with Benediction at 5:30 pm on Sunday, April 7th. Holy Mass will follow immediately afterwards at 6 pm. At times during Saturday and Sunday, the Blessed Sacrament will be reposed in the tabernacle during the weekend Masses, but there will be many hours during the two days and nights to come and pray before Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. There will be other prayer opportunities that will take place during this time, including Reconciliation on April 6th from 10 am to noon, that we hope will enhance parishioners’ prayers.

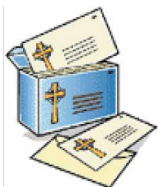

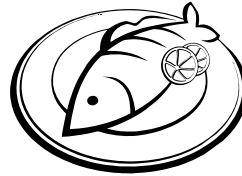

Please note that if you are unable to join us in prayer during these times, please pray and fast for the unborn and their parents.

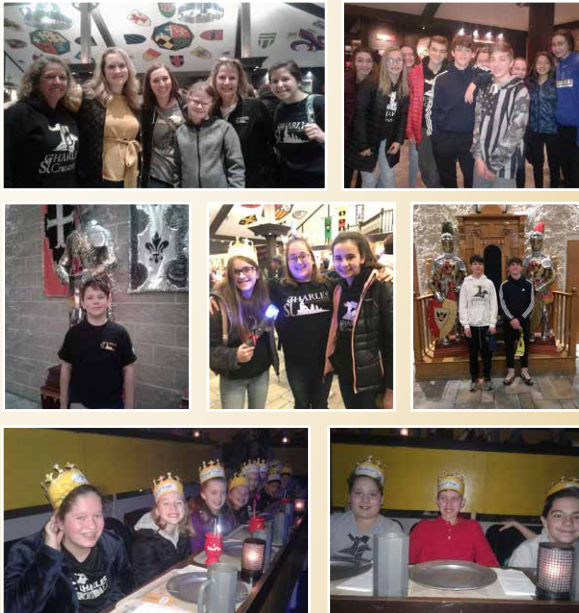

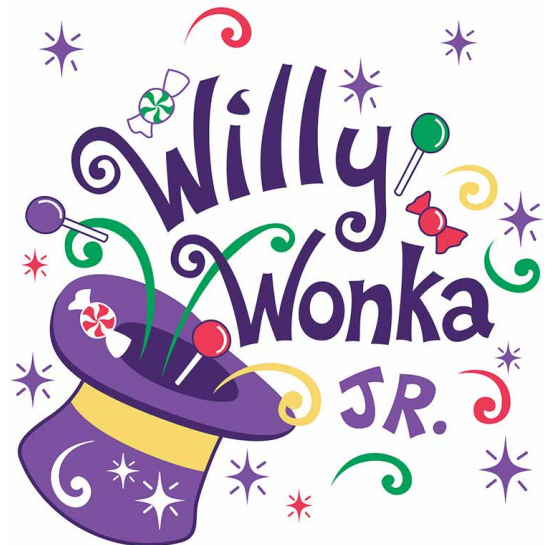

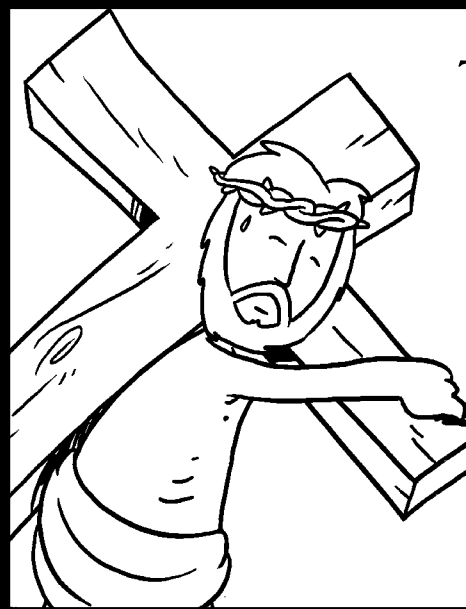
