Upcoming Changes at St. Charles and St. Teresa of Calcutta Parishes

This announcement was made after all Masses at St. Charles and St. Teresa Parishes on May 4 & 5.

At the suggestion of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and their chief operating officer Mr. Brad Berghouse, we began to explore the possibility of ending the cluster arrangement between St. Charles and St. Teresa Parishes. Although we were functioning quite well as a cluster for 14 months, the difference in scale became very clear – St. Charles has 2,500 households in comparison to St. Teresa’s 650 households. One of the ideas that we began exploring was to separate the two parishes so they would no longer be clustered and St. Teresa would have a Parish Director. After consultation with Fr. Jerry Herda, the Vicar for Clergy, and Archbishop ListECKI the consensus was that this would be a superior arrangement - having St. Charles as a free-standing parish with a full-time Pastor and St. Teresa as a free-standing parish with a Parish Director.

The Archbishop was pleased to assign Deacon Allen, who is currently on staff at St. Teresa’s, to the role of Parish Director. This arrangement will take effect on July 1st. This continuity in leadership will allow for a seamless transition. It isn’t that the cluster wasn’t successful. It is that this arrangement will be more effective. The Archdiocese has also made this change with two other parish clusters.

Deacon Allen will have the support of all the wonderful staff at St. Teresa, especially his Amazing Parish Team of Mary Jo Romportl and Rick Berger who will work closely with him. Fr. Ken will continue as the Pastor of St. Charles and also will be the Supervising Priest for St. Teresa. Masses at St. Teresa will be provided by assisting priests.



St. Charles Parish and School Welcomes New Associate Pastor Deacon Nicholas Baumgardner

Deacon Nick was born and raised in Greendale, Wisconsin. The second youngest of seven kids, Dcn. Nick thought about being a priest from a very young age.

When asked by an elementary school teacher which four things he wanted to be when he grew up, he promptly replied: "Priest, Bishop, Cardinal, Pope."

After attending St. Alphonsus Grade School in Greendale, he went on to Pius XI High School and eventually to University of Wisconsin-Madison for college. At Madison he studied chemical engineering.

While at Madison he also grew in his faith through his involvement at the St. Paul University Catholic Center. After his sophomore year in college, he spent a summer on staff at Catholic

Youth Expeditions (CYE) in Door County. This time on CYE staff was incredibly influential in his eventual decision to enter seminary after his junior year at Madison.

Transferring to St. Joseph College Seminary on the campus of Loyola University Chicago, Dcn. Nick later graduated with a degree in philosophy. He subsequently began his theology studies, the final stage of his seminary formation, at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in St. Francis, Wisconsin.

Dcn. Nick is thrilled about being assigned to St. Charles. He spent six weeks at St. Charles during the summer after his first year in college seminary, and he has nothing but fond memories of his time at the parish.

Dcn. Nick is known for his long-distance running and for being a bit of a coffee snob. He also enjoys reading, both fiction and non-fiction. If he had to pick a favorite author it would probably be C.S. Lewis.

More importantly, he has a great love for Jesus Christ and His Church, and has a strong devotion to St. Augustine, St. Ignatius of Loyola, St. Faustina, and the Blessed Mother.

As a concluding note and clarification, Dcn. Nick is more than content to be a parish priest, and has no interest in ever becoming Bishop, Cardinal, or Pope.
