Take the 1% Challenge and get to know Jesus!

ASK (3 Minutes)

- Begin in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit
- Take a moment to be still, rest and know that Jesus is here ...
- Ask Jesus to help you get to know Him during this prayer time.
- Say, "Lord, teach me to pray."

SEEK (7 Minutes)

- After reading the day's scripture, take some time to reflect in silence on one or more of the following questions:
 - What word or phrases in this passage caught your attention?
 - What in this passage comforted you?
 - What in this passage challenged you?
- Re-read the passage.
- Take a few minutes to simply listen and then respond with: "I hear the Lord saying to me ..."

KNOCK (5 Minutes)

- Based on what you hear the Lord saying to you, ask Him what He wants you to do today or this week in light of His will for you.
- Listen to His answer to you and then respond by saying, "I believe the Lord wants me to ..."
- Ask the Lord for what you need to respond to His word. Thank Him for being with you today.
- Close with an Our Father. End in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

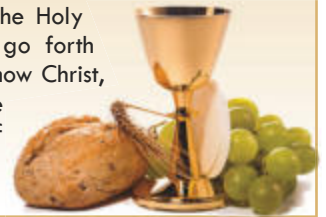

FOOD PANTRY NEEDS: flour, beef stew, sugar - all varieties, Saltines, brownie mix, cream style corn and paper towels. (Please note - we do not need canned tuna for the remainder of 2019; we were blessed with a large donation.)

Next week is SHARE SUNDAY! This is SVdP's monthly collection to benefit the patrons of the food pantry and your opportunity for charitable works if you haven't been able to donate throughout the month. Food, paper and hygiene products in short supply are listed weekly in the bulletin. The morning shift on Tuesday, May 14th served 19 families. That meant 76 rolls of toilet paper, 19 rolls of paper towels, 19 boxes of Kleenex, 19 boxes of cereal, along with other needs such as juice, spaghetti sauce, deodorant, peanut butter, canned fruit, sugar, soup and canned meats were needed. Volunteers restocked the shelves to prepare for the evening hours where many additional families required even more products. In addition, monies donated to the pantry are needed to cover monthly rent, utilities and insurance payments. If you prefer to donate cash, envelopes are located at the SVdP collection boxes in the narthex and next to the hall sign-up shelf. Please mark food pantry on the memo portion of your check or envelope for cash donations. All monies not indicated will be given to our general fund to assist those who need help with rent, security deposits, utilities, medical bills, car repairs, clothing, furniture and other needs. Thank you for helping our ministry help those who live with less.

If you need assistance, please contact SVdP at 262-367-0800. If you need food, the pantry is located at 229 Lawn Street, Hartland and is open Tuesdays between 10 AM and noon. It is also open on the second and fourth Tuesday evening of the month between 5:30 pm and 7 pm.

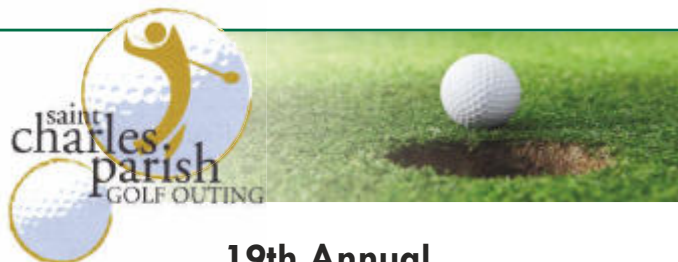
