

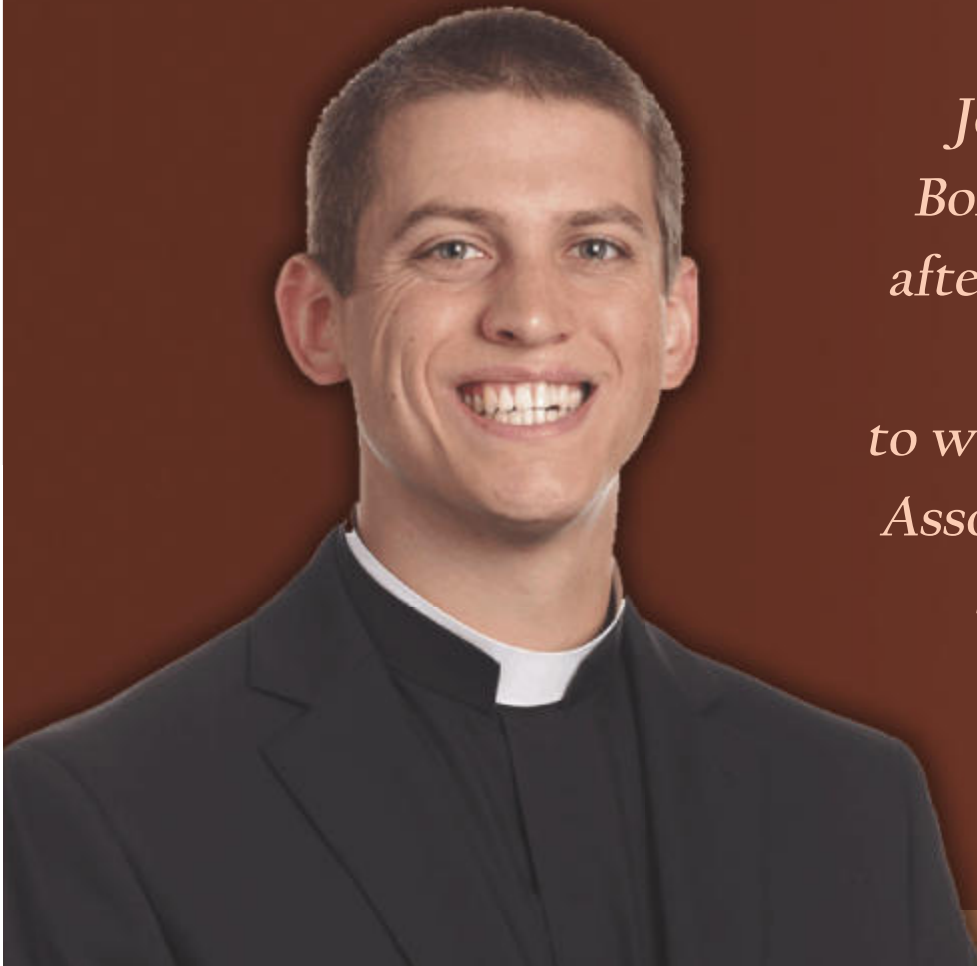

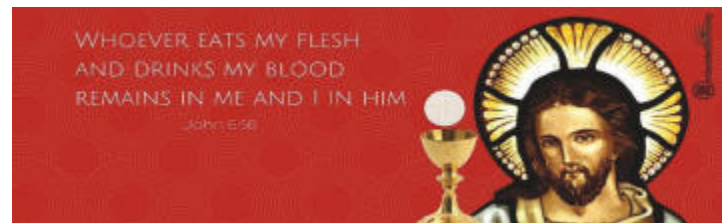
Support Our Grocers & Help St. Charles
