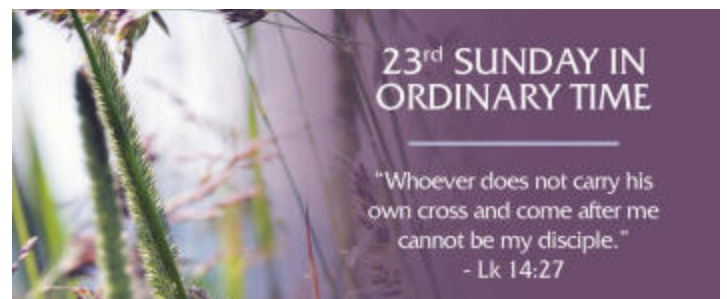

He was a journalist, lawyer, scholar, professor at the Sorbonne, husband, father, and the founder of the Conference of Charity when he was only 20 years old. This later became known as the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. Frederic believed in the worth and value of every human being, working tirelessly to aid the poor living in vile conditions in Paris tenements. Your fellow parishioners continue the work of Blessed Frederic to assist those in your community who live on limited incomes and often face dire circumstances. 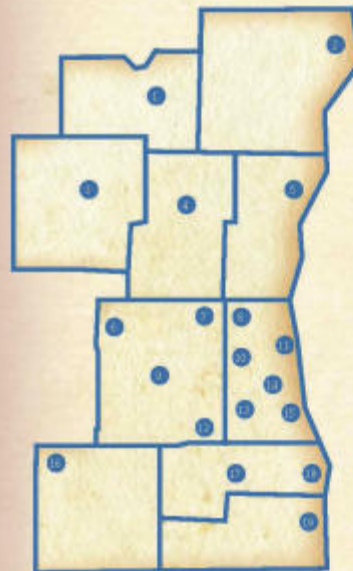

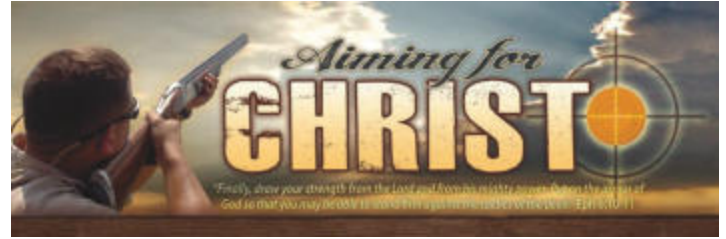
