SAINT CHARLES BORROMEIO

Feast Day - November 4th

Patron of Bishops, Catechists, Cardinals, Seminarists and Spiritual Leaders.

About Our Patron Saint Saint Charles Borromeo

St. Charles, of the noble family Borromeo, was born on October 2, 1538 in the castle of Arona at Lake Maggiore in Italy. He received the clerical tonsure at 12, as soon as his age would allow. He studied at Milan and later at the University of Pavia, where he received his doctorate in civil and canon law in 1559.

In the same year, his uncle, the Cardinal de Medici, was elected Pope under the title of Pius IV. In 1560, Pope Pius IV appointed St. Charles, then 22, cardinal and archbishop of Milan.

Later, as papal secretary of state, St. Charles was instrumental in reassembling the Council of Trent in 1562. He also led the efforts to implement the Council, including the composition of the Roman Catechism, which contained the teaching of the Council.

Among his many contributions to the Church, he encouraged the proper training of priests by founding several seminaries and colleges. He also supported religious instruction of children.

His relief measures in Milan saved many lives during the plague of 1576-78.

St. Charles died on November 3 in Milan at the age of 47. He was canonized in 1610. His feast day is November 4.

A few days ago, we celebrated the Solemnity of All Saints. This feast celebrates not only the saints we know about, but those who are unknown to us- those who have not been canonized. There are, we believe, many more saints in heaven than known to the Church on earth who pray and intercede for us- the Church Militant- and the Church Penitent. This communion of saints reaches down to us in love, and begs God for our sanctification. For us to join them in heaven would only increase their already infinite joy.

Through Becoming Fully Catholic, we walk with those people who desire to join the Church more fully through baptism, reception, or confirmation. We are to pray for these catechumens and candidates, begging God for their sanctification, just as all the saints in heaven do. We ought to take our example from the saints who rejoice when someone becomes a child of God, our brother or sister in Christ. Have you ever thought about your role in the Becoming Fully Catholic process in this way? The most important thing we can do for our catechumens and candidates is to pray for them. Intercede for them, instruct them, and express great joy when they step closer to the throne of God.


In many ways we are also catechumens. We walk through our lives in faith and seek the face of God. Our reception into the Church Triumphant mirrors the sacraments of initiation here below, and our sponsors are the Saints. Join with our catechumens and candidates in the walk to initiation- our journeys are similar. Join with the saints in prayer and intercession for our catechumens and candidates- these roles are similar. You walk a line, straddling heaven and earth. Take hold of it.
