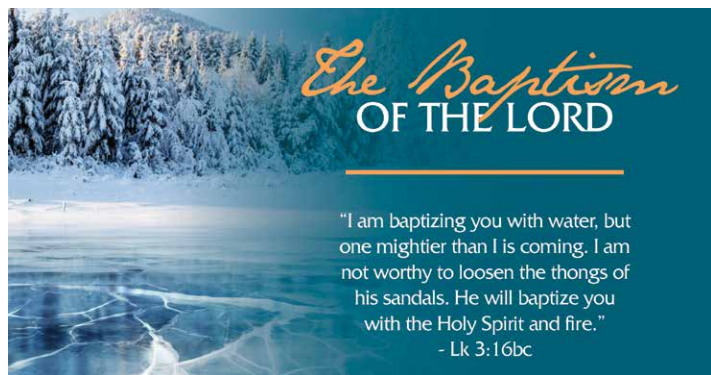

JANUARY IS POVERTY AWARENESS MONTH! On Tuesday morning, Dec. 18th, 30 families visited the food pantry. That day alone, 120 rolls of toilet paper, 30 boxes of Kleenex, 30 rolls of paper towels, 30 bottles of laundry detergent, 30 bottles of dish-washing liquid, 30 jars of mayonnaise, 30 boxes of cereal, 60 cans of soup, 30 cans of meat, 30 jars of peanut butter, 30 jars of jelly, 30 bottles of spaghetti sauce and 30 boxes of noodles were needed. In addition, patrons also chose sugar, flour, pancake syrup, pancake mix, brownie and cake mixes, vegetables, canned fruit, rice, flavored sides, boxed potatoes, deodorant and shampoo. We began the day with only 3 bottles of juice and little laundry detergent. Yet all needs were met as several people dropped off donations of much needed items, fresh oranges and grapefruits and stocking stuffers for patrons' children. The families who use the pantry may be experiencing job loss, poverty, high medical bills or living on limited fixed incomes. They are very grateful for the kind hearts that lighten their burdens. Thank you for helping us reflect the face of Christ as we care for others.

FOOD PANTRY NEEDS: juice, applesauce, mayonnaise, canned peaches, canned pineapple, canned hams, ketchup, mustard, laundry detergent, Kleenex, paper towels and toilet paper.

If you need the assistance of SVdP, please contact us at 262-367-0800. If you need food, the pantry is located at 229 Lawn Street, Hartland. It is open Tuesdays between 10 AM and noon. It is also open on the second and fourth Tuesday evening of each month between 5:30 PM and 7 PM.

The food pantry will close when Arrowhead Schools close for inclement weather. It will reopen the following Tuesday, weather permitting.

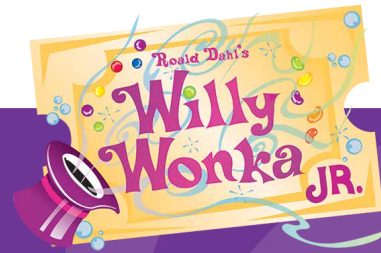

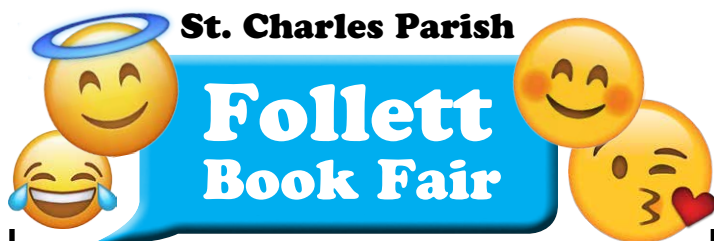


