## THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT




### NEW Monthly Tuesday Evening Mass at St. Charles

This March St. Charles will begin offering a monthly Tuesday evening Mass at 5:30 p.m. **The first three Masses will be on March 24, April 21 and May 26.** Our goal in offering this Mass is to help facilitate the participation of young adults and families who might otherwise not be able to make it to our daily morning Mass. We also hope that this Mass will be an opportunity to encounter some of the ancient treasures of the Mass. One of these treasures is the celebration of the Mass in a common direction. To celebrate Mass in this way, the priest and the people face each other when they are speaking to each other (e.g. "The Lord be with you... And with your spirit"), and they face a common direction – toward Christ on the crucifix – when they are together speaking directly to God (e.g. during the Eucharistic Prayer). Another treasure is the Latin language, the use of which the Second Vatican Council wished to preserve (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy n. 36). During our Tuesday evening Masses we will use Latin to sing those parts of the Mass that do not change from week to week: e.g. the Gloria; the Holy, Holy, Holy; the Our Father; and the Lamb of God. The rest of the Mass will be in English. While these treasures are indeed ancient, they are also ever new. While some of us may not be familiar with them, they still exist in the Church's treasury, waiting to be brought out and encountered by the next generation. **Take the 1% Challenge and get to know Jesus!**

**ASK (3 Minutes)**

- Begin in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit
- Take a moment to be still, rest and know that Jesus is here ...
- Ask Jesus to help you get to know Him during this prayer time.
- Say, "Lord, teach me to pray."

**SEEK (7 Minutes)**

- After reading the day's scripture, take some time to reflect in silence on one or more of the following questions:
  - What word or phrases in this passage caught your attention?
  - What in this passage comforted you?
  - What in this passage challenged you?
- Re-read the passage.
- Take a few minutes to simply listen and then respond with: "I hear the Lord saying to me ..."

**KNOCK (5 Minutes)**

- Based on what you hear the Lord saying to you, ask Him what He wants you to do today or this week in light of His will for you.
- Listen to His answer to you and then respond by saying, "I believe the Lord wants me to ..."
- Ask the Lord for what you need to respond to His word. Thank Him for being with you today.
- Close with an Our Father. End in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

In the early Church, catechumens- those to be baptized at Easter- were set apart even more from the Christian community in the penitential season. Intense training and testing took the form of increased prayer, more mortifications, longer fasts, and increased almsgiving. For forty days, the catechumens prepared their hearts and souls for their new birth, the Incarnation of Christ in their hearts. They worked to soften their hearts of stone to prepare for a new heart of flesh, one to be engraved with God's Word. They entered the desert with Jesus and fought the devil off as he panics at his loss of souls to Heaven.

After a time, the rest of the Church looked at herself and realized that this forty day period of intense prayer, fasting, and almsgiving would benefit them as well. From that point on, Christians entered into a renewed catechumenate during Lent. They united with the catechumens in sackcloth and ashes, allowing themselves to be taught and led by the example of the unbaptized. On the third Sunday in Lent, the readings shift to focus on baptism, and prompt an interior reflection in preparation for being sprinkled with Easter water, baptismal water.

We, the baptized, ask ourselves how we respond to Jesus' thirst for us. We search our hearts and question if we truly believe or if we are going through the motions. We reflect on ourselves as the image of Christ, and put ourselves through trials to further conform ourselves to the Imago Dei.

"Reflecting on those questions, the already-baptized experience a new catechumenate, a period of preparing to go up to Jerusalem with Jesus, who will meet his messianic destiny there – and who, in embracing that destiny in obedience to the Father, will be revealed as the Risen Lord who makes all things new, including our brokenness... That is what Lent is for. The 'annual catechumenate' of Lent prepares us to be missionary disciples who can display the divine mercy because we have known it in our lives." -George Weigel, 'Lent: The Annual Catechumenate.' March 26, 2014.

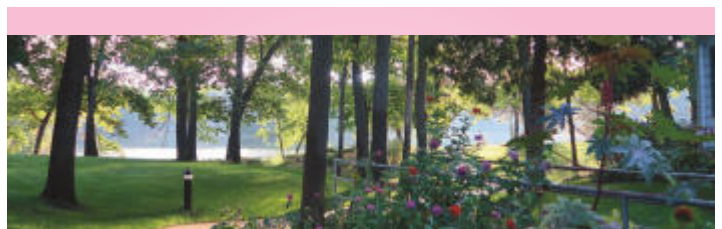
