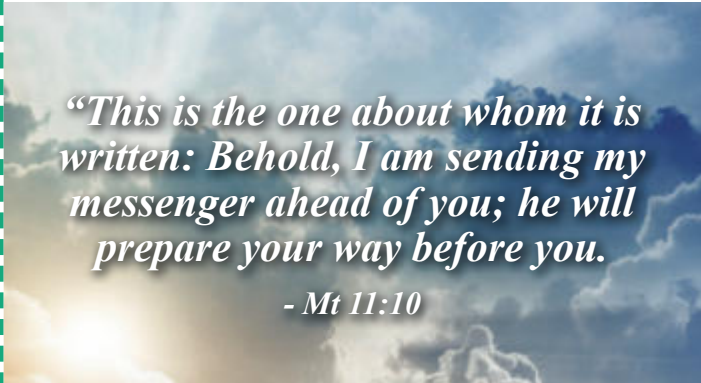

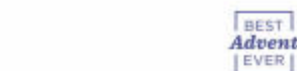


CHRISTMAS BAKE SALE

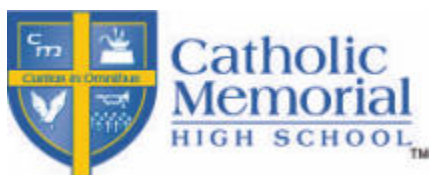
