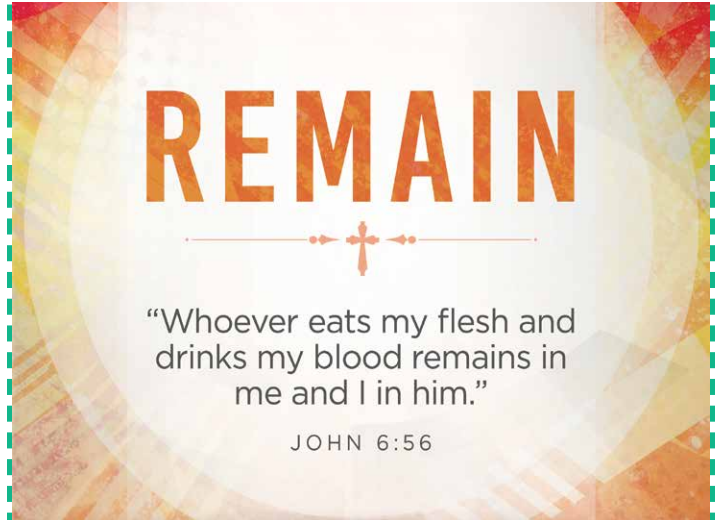

## Falling in Love with the Ordinary

The first time I ever thought about being a priest, which has led to the journey I am currently on being a deacon, was playing basketball with a priest. Growing up in Glendale, my life was what

most would consider normal and ordinary. Perhaps that was the reason playing a simple basketball game in our driveway with the local priest led to my first desire for priesthood. Priests had always seemed special growing up, and they still are. But the reason the priest appears so special did not present itself to me until I began to reflect on the past month of being a deacon myself. For in all the changes the past month have brought to my life, I found that it is not the excitement of being a deacon that I love, but how ordinary it is. And it is in this ordinary life where I have found God to be most present.

The priest who played basketball with me so many years ago revealed this to me. God did not have to be found in fantastic miracles or profound visions (although when He is, they are glorious); God could be found at all times right in front me. God is found when I take a walk and marvel at the beauty and uniqueness of a passing tree. God is found in the smell of freshly-baked cookies (although I prefer the dough). God is even found in emptying the dishwasher so Fr. Nick doesn't have to do it. All of these became concrete examples of God's constant love for me.

I soon realized that as I grow in my love of God and my vocation as deacon, I fall in love with the ordinary more and more. This love is especially made real when visiting people and being invited into their homes. Hearing about their family vacation, work, hobbies, pets, and even worries and concerns reveals the full beauty of the ordinary.

In the Gospels, we hear Jesus doing precisely this. Story after story tells Jesus engaging with people in the ordinary life, eating, conversing, walking, sleeping, going to weddings and funerals, riding boats and donkeys. Jesus, who is God, did everything that we do on a daily basis. This means that God did everything we do on a daily basis. God walked, God ate, God slept, God talked. In other words, whenever we walk, eat, sleep, or talk, we are doing things God himself did. Wow!

As a deacon, I find that much of my role is helping people fall in love with the ordinary just as I continue to do so. I also think this is what all of us are called to bring to the world: a love of the ordinary. A love which reminds people that God is loving them every second of every day. A love which makes it possible to find God in a simple game of basketball.

Our hearts were on fire to see many of you as we resumed public weekend Masses on May 30/31! We thank our Lord (and staff, ushers, Eucharistic Ministers and Knights of Columbus too!) for a great first weekend back since safer-at-home restrictions went into place. ## RECENT FAQ'S ABOUT MASS AND THE PARISH

### Mass-Related Questions

#### 1. When can I attend Mass?

You are invited to attend our weekend Masses. We are continuing to offer our Masses at the same times as we have before: Saturdays at 5pm and Sundays at 7am, 9am, 11am, and 6pm.

#### 2. Can I still livestream Mass?

Absolutely! We are livestreaming all of our Masses and will continue to until the Archbishop's dispensation ends on July 6.

#### 3. Am I able to attend Daily Mass?

Daily Masses are not open to the public at this time but are being livestreamed on our website.

#### 4. How can I get tickets to Mass? What if I don't have a computer or internet? Can I walk in instead?

You can reserve seats for Mass on the homepage of our website. Click the Mass Tickets button to be directed to Brown Paper Tickets, our ticketing system. If you do not have a computer or internet access, you can have a family member or friend reserve a ticket for you instead through that system. Our parish office can also reserve tickets for you if needed.

We will be seating ticket holders first for Masses. If there are spots available after seating is complete, we will invite walk-ins to join us in our Borromeo Room and/or Parish Hall for Mass.

#### 5. Are masks required? What if I don't have a mask?

Yes, masks are required. If you do not have a mask, we will provide one for you.

#### 6. What should I expect at Mass?

Masses will look a little bit different as we continue to follow guidelines from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. To learn more about what to expect at Mass, please read through our list of procedures before you purchase a ticket.

#### 7. Is Little Lambs childcare available during Mass?

Childcare is currently not available during our Masses. We will let you know when it is being offered again.

#### 8. What should I do if my infant/child gets fussy during Mass?

You are able to leave church to calm your infant or child. We ask that you comfort your child in the hallway and return to your seat as soon as you are able.

#### 9. May I take Communion home to distribute to friends, family, etc.?

You are unable to take Communion with you at this time.

#### 10. Are priests available after Mass?

Our priests will return to their offices after Mass has ended. We ask that all attendees depart as soon as possible so that we can sanitize the church prior to the next Mass. Thank you for your cooperation!

### Other Questions

#### 1. Are parish offices open?

Yes, we have a limited number of staff in our parish office at this time. Please contact us Monday-Friday from 8am to 4pm at 262-367-0800 with any questions you may have.

#### 2. Am I able to come into the church to pray?

Private prayer time will resume on June 8 from 9:30am to 3:30pm.

#### 3. Can I still receive Reconciliation? Can I arrange it with a priest?

Reconciliation is available on Thursday evenings starting at 5pm. Please contact the Parish Office at 262-367-0800 to set up an appointment with Fr. Ken or Fr. Nick if you are unavailable on Thursday evenings.

#### 4. Can I come for Eucharistic Adoration?

Eucharistic Adoration is not open to the public at this time. It will be livestreamed until it reopens to the public.

#### 5. Am I able to schedule a baptism, wedding, or funeral?

Yes! Please contact our Parish Office at 262-367-0800 if you would like to schedule a baptism, wedding, or funeral. Please note, though, that there may be restrictions in terms of how many people can attend these events.

#### 6. When will I know about rescheduled dates for events such as First Communion and Reconciliation?

Our ministries are in the process of rescheduling many events that were cancelled throughout the Spring. We are receiving guidance from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and will notify you of rescheduled dates as soon as possible.

#### 7. Is there anything I can do to help St. Charles?

There are a variety of ways you can help us! First and foremost we ask for your prayers. We are still accepting weekly offerings via the mail and drop-offs. You can also donate through E-giving on our website. If you are interested in helping local families in need, you are able to drop off non-perishable food items or monetary donations for St. Vincent de Paul in the foyer, as well.

#### 8. Is the Cornerstone Project still on schedule?

Like so many initiatives in our community and across the country, our Cornerstone building project has been postponed to help keep everyone as safe as possible during this pandemic. We hope to break ground in the Fall of 2020.

While we know this delay causes some frustration, our committees and staff see this as an opportunity to review each aspect of the construction and look for areas to improve our efficiency that will hopefully result in some savings.

## WISCONSIN CATHOLIC CONFERENCE

### STATEMENT OF THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS OF WISCONSIN ON UNJUST KILLINGS AND RECENT PROTESTS

Dearly Beloved,

In this traumatic time, we join with our [brother bishops and committee chairmen of United States Conference of Catholic Bishops \(USCCB\)](#) in expressing our anger and tremendous sorrow over the recent brutal death of George Floyd and the violence that people of color have suffered at the hands of vigilantes and unprincipled public authorities across our nation. These unjust acts have unfortunately plagued our state and nation for centuries. All of us must respond with prayer, solidarity, and solace for the victims and their families, but this continuing brutality calls for even greater effort and action.

We encourage everyone to examine any attitudes of racism within themselves or others that contribute to a culture of disrespect of the dignity and rights of every human person. As noted in the USCCB statement “People of good conscience must never turn a blind eye when citizens are being deprived of their human dignity and even their lives. Indifference is not an option. ‘As bishops, we unequivocally state that racism is a life issue.’”

“Too many communities around this country feel their voices are not being heard, their complaints about racist treatment are unheeded, and we are not doing enough to point out that this deadly treatment is antithetical to the Gospel of Life.”

May God change all our hearts, allowing us to recognize, cherish, and defend the dignity of every human life, for everyone is made in the image and likeness of God and deserves to live free from fear and harm.

We support and join with those who speak out against injustice and applaud efforts to peaceably protest against the murder of George Floyd and others who have been struck down by prejudice and abuse of power. We echo the call for swift and certain justice and we condemn the actions of those who resort to violence, which only further damages underserved communities and distracts from the issues that need our attention.

We implore, for the safety of all, that those who protest in public, especially in communities of color, take appropriate preventative measures to avoid the further spread of COVID-19. Our communities of color in Wisconsin are facing disproportionately high rates of COVID-19 infection. Needless spread will only compound challenges in these communities.
