## A Conversation with Jon Ingrisano

(Part 2 of 2)

### LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

Per the School Commission's guidelines, the outgoing Chair is asked to stay on for one more year as an emeritus member. This year also coincides with Jon's youngest child's eighth grade year at St. Charles. As he reflects on his time on the Commission, Jon feels confident in what the future holds.

*"My role was to make sure that we have a school with the infrastructure in place in the School Commission to keep going in the direction that we want to go," he says. "We have to keep our parents engaged and to know that there's a Commission in place to put the school in the best position possible. Because of that, there's been succession planning with the chairperson. As we become a bigger school, things become more economically complex."*

With this thought in mind, the Commission focused on bringing in more people with financial backgrounds. This led to Dave Burns transitioning into the Commission Chair this year.

*"Dave Burns was an easy choice for the next School Commission Chair," Jon says. "Not only does he have a great financial mind and has done a fantastic job leading our financial subcommittee, he has a great temperament and fosters consensus. I really feel like we're in good hands moving forward with Dave, and I'm looking forward to seeing the great work he's able to do."*

Jon has a few goals that he is hoping to accomplish as he continues contributing to the Commission throughout this school year.

*"Prior to COVID, one of my main goals was to continue the growth of the School," he says. "While we still have a great foundation, we now unexpectedly need to regroup and restart our momentum. I'm sad to see some families leaving our school at such a critical time. I believe that we are called to be stewards of the Church, its mission, and its works. I have a personal responsibility to St. Charles Parish School, and my family is committed this year and beyond. I pray that others have the same perspective."*

*I also want to continue Fr. Ken's vision, which is the parish and school as one community. Even after I leave the role, I want to still bring the perspective to fellow parishioners that one of the things that gives us the character we have as a parish is the vibrant and growing school with young, dedicated families. At the same time, school families should recognize that their school is the product of a strong, supportive parish that takes seriously its role as steward."*

He ultimately wants to see the School Commission continue to flourish, as well.

*"My hope is for the Commission to keep drawing strong parishioners and school parents to the team and to keep being a resource for the principal and pastor during the ups and the downs," Jon says. "That means having good people who are dedicated to Catholic identity and*

*strong education. Fr. Ken and Dan Garvey are well positioned to keep growth in the parish and school going. The School Commission has to continue to be there to provide our best counsel that we can."*

Jon is grateful for the opportunity to lead and to make a lasting impact at St. Charles.

*"I want to give my thanks to Fr. Ken for his faith in me and the support he's shown me," he says. "And I want to thank the school community for all of the support they've shown me throughout the years."*

In turn, Dave Burns and Dan Garvey are thankful for all of Jon's contributions, as well.

*"I'm very grateful for Jon's leadership and selfless devotion of his time and talents over the years as Chair of the St. Charles Parish School Commission," Dave says. "His pragmatic, thoughtful, and prayerful approach, combined with his genuine love for the parish and school, has served all of us at St. Charles well, and it was a pleasure to serve on the Commission during his time as Chair."*

*"Jon has been instrumental to the success of St. Charles because of his passion for Catholic education and dedication to Christ's work," Dan says. "I am eternally grateful for his leadership during his time as School Commission Chair. It has been a lot of fun working together these past two years as we share a drive for excellence, and I look forward to continuing this partnership for years to come. I want to thank Jon for working to ensure St. Charles Parish School is a place where our students and families can experience God's Word and Love each and every day."*
