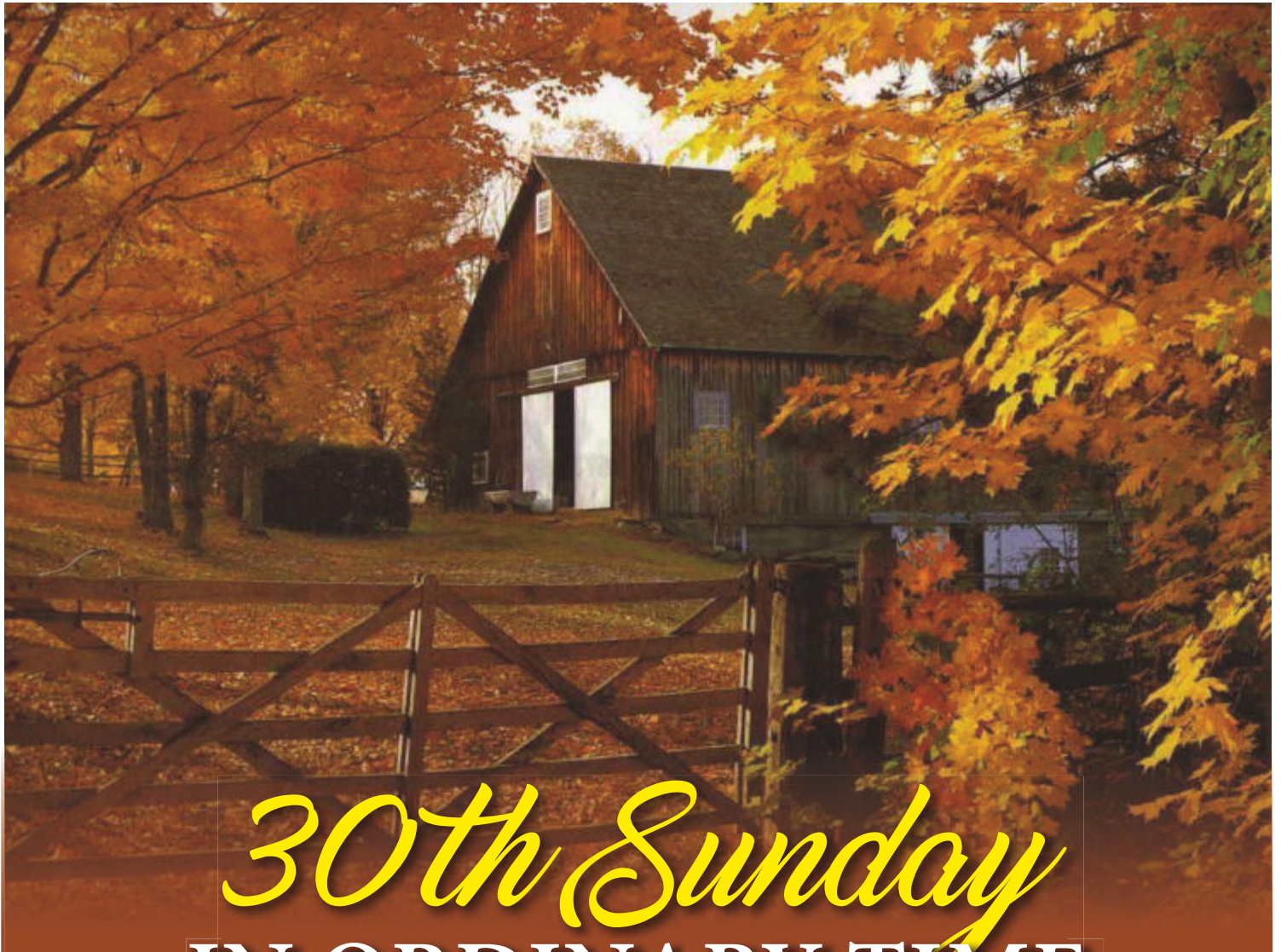

### LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Do we really understand how important our relationships with our brothers and sisters throughout the world truly are? Many give God's commandment to love your neighbor and yourself a congenial glance of approval and agreement without really thinking about the implications. Sometimes it is easier to kneel in reverence before the tabernacle in a church than to kneel in reverence before the tabernacle of another person's soul. Witnessing and being consumed by the Divine Power alive in the heart of every living being transforms not only how we see our brothers and sisters but how we see God Himself. The cries of the poor and those who are hurting must echo in our hearts. We can no longer be deaf to the world's pain. It is no longer acceptable to judge others, unduly

criticize, or marginalize, neglect, abuse, manipulate, or participate in the exploitation of anyone! We are asked to become hypersensitive to not only what we are doing but why we are doing it. This holds true not only with regard to the daily conduct of our lives but our economic and corporate relationships and policies as well.

### THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION 30TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

For some reason, it is easier to genuflect in reverence to the presence of Christ in the tabernacle of a church than to genuflect in reverence to the same presence of Christ in another person's soul. We wrongly believe that God divides himself, placing himself in one place in preference to another. It doesn't work that way. Love of God and love of neighbor are intimately and inseparably connected because the essence and spark of God's very presence is in all creation. God's presence is just as real in the one who is good, as in the one who is bad, and the one who is just, and the one who is unjust.

Our brains get in the way of truly contemplating the awesomeness of this truth. We like to separate things into boxes, the sheep from the goats and the deserving from the undeserving. But with God there are no distinctions such as this. Our human classifications, subdivisions, and definitions hold no power or have any weight in God's eyes. Sadly, we relate to God and to each other as if they do.

We cannot be deaf to the world's pain. It is not about having, hoarding, accumulating, acquiring, securing, storing, protecting, owning, claiming, or any of the other human terms we use to distinguish mine from yours. We put so much power in these words and that power, even though we may not always realize it, can cause those words and the distinctions they carry to wound and hurt others. We have the whole order of things wrong, but we are so set on preserving this order that we are absolutely afraid to do it any other way. We go through hoops trying to convince ourselves why the perils of the person seeking a new place to call home are not our perils that we turn our back and justify closing our doors. It makes perfect sense to us. Yet, it makes no sense in terms of our faith. It doesn't square with any of the words found in Sacred Scripture or in any time-tested teaching of the church.

We have it all reversed. We know that we do because when Jesus speaks about such things and the words of the Old Testament prophets ring out again, we start to feel uncomfortable and anxious. What we do, directly or by omission, to one of the least of these little ones we do to God. It is quite possible that some of what we are doing personally, economically, politically, globally, and even religiously is doing more harm than good. Let's ponder that a bit.

MEET ROBERT

Hailing from Highland, Indiana, Robert attended Bishop Simon Bruté College Seminary in Indianapolis for four years before spending the last two years at St. Francis de Sales Seminary. He entered the seminary after graduating from high school and attributes his decision to discern to the priesthood to many different factors.

"I grew up in a devoutly Catholic family that was always involved in Church," he says. "My uncle is a priest, and we went to his parish, where I was able to serve at the altar. Also, when I was growing up, my older brother entered the seminary, and he is now a priest today. People have joked that serving the Church is the Ross 'family business.'"

The decision to enter the seminary has been life changing for Robert.

"The formation I have received has helped me change my life to the point that I don't recognize myself when I first entered seminary," he says. "I have also had the opportunity to meet amazing Catholics and make strong friendships."

He's had incredible opportunities pop up such as seeing Pope Francis in Washington D.C. for the canonization of St. Junipero Serra, traveling to Krakow, Poland for World Youth Day, and making a pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

Robert is excited to be at St. Charles and is looking forward to all that he can learn while he is here.

"I have never been in a parish as large as St. Charles before," he says. "I am looking forward to seeing the Catholic Church in its youthful vibrancy and learning some of the skills it takes to manage and keep healthy such a large community of people. 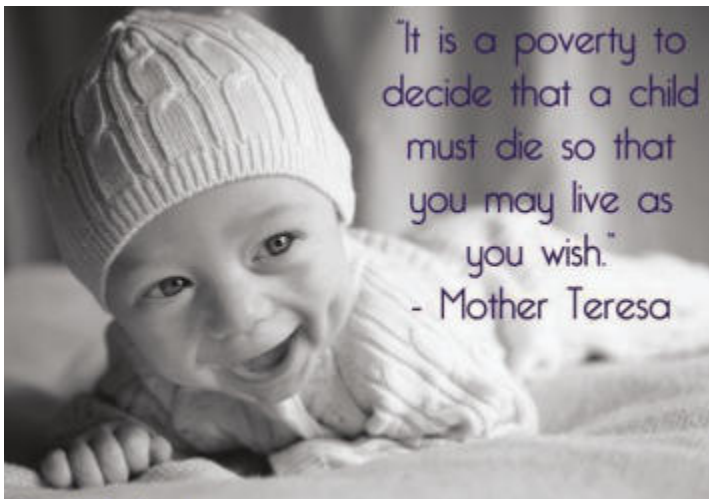
# 40 DAYS FOR LIFE™

### EVERYDAY SAINTS

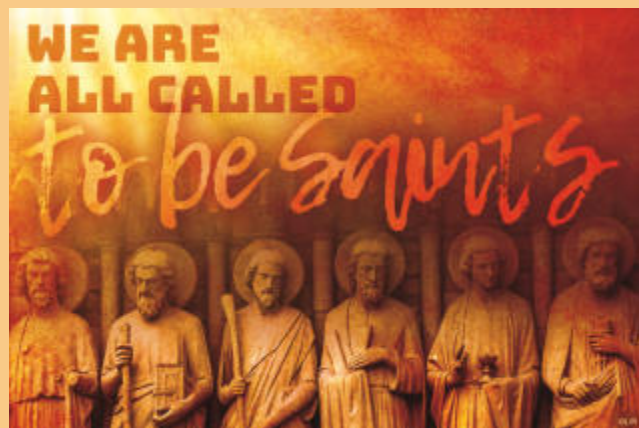

Now that I am older, I realize that I was wrong back then and my immaturity of both mind and heart did not allow me to see that there are saints among us all the time. I have met many people in my life that I would call living saints. They are holy people who give of themselves to God and others in profound ways. Their relationship with Jesus is evident, and they live their lives in ways that people witness the transformative power of love.

If we are still thinking like children, we may choose to stay silent and live accordingly.
