THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

“Remain in my love,” and “I call you friends” are powerful words that are found in John’s Gospel. Most of us probably have them committed to memory or have at least heard them proclaimed dozens of times. They are words that can easily become trite and quickly glossed over without fully pondering and digesting their profound beauty. When we take the time to immerse ourselves in them, they can radically change our lives and our relationships. They can open up new doors of adventure and hold countless possibilities for meaning. The essence of love and friendship are things that can easily be taken for granted. They have always been there and are a significant part of our lives. Many would say that they could not live without love and friendship, and they put a great deal of care into preserving, deepening and sustaining them. Love and friendship share a mutual relationship with each other that deserves more reflection.

Where does love come from? We can consider relationships that have not succeeded and conclude that they were somehow due to our “failures in love.” In doing so, we assume that human beings are the ones responsible for love, its success and also its failure. While our weakness, emotional composition and sinfulness can easily impact our ability to love, its origin is not human. God is love. God is love’s author and origin. When we love, it is God who loves in and through us. It is because of this divine closeness that Jesus is able to call us friends! It is not because of anything we have done but simply because of who we are. Realizing and contemplating this awesome reality becomes a game changer across the board. It gives us reason to clear the table of anything that can adversely affect the way we love so that we can open the door for its author to shine forth.

Coming upon this truth is what leads folks like St. Francis of Assisi to leave that which is comfortable and worldly and live a radical life. They relate with the love of God that radiates in and through all living things and appreciate their sacredness. It was having an intimate experience of God’s love and friendship that propelled St. Francis and others to embrace simplicity, act nonviolently, pursue humility, love enemies, care for the earth and open up avenues for true justice. Understanding this profound truth will also help us find peaceful solutions to the world’s problems, restore relationships with our sisters and brothers, bring the grace of loving stewardship to creation and heal many wounds. Once we begin to see how wonderfully holy all of life really is, we discover joy. We lose our need for fear, develop a fierce fortitude, act prudently and seek justice. There is great power in love because it comes from God. It will never fail. It also enjoys the company of two other friends who are eager to become our friends as well: faith and hope. These are just as important to have and to share.

- We hear Jesus’ prayer to his Father for the protection of the disciples, especially against “the evil one” in the world. Where do you personally experience evil in the world today?

UPDATES TO ST. CHARLES' MASSES AND THE ARCHDIOCESE CATHOLIC COMEBACK MATRIX

- Starting Monday, May 3rd, Rosary prayer time will start at 8:30 am, allowing those who come to pray the rosary to stay for the 9 am Mass.
- Beginning this Sunday, May 9th, our 11 am Sunday Mass will be mask-optional. Masks will no longer be required at our 11 am Sunday Masses. For now, we will continue to require masks at our other Masses.
- Matrix Update - We are happy to inform you that we are now able to resume additional ministries that have been deferred during the pandemic. You will notice that the **worship aids** are back in the pews and the missalettes are in the racks for general use. We will also have hard copy worship aids for our daily Masses, as well. Beginning Thursday, May 6th, **Reconciliation** will now take place in both the Reconciliation Room and the Chapel. This weekend, May 8th and 9th, we will again be able to have the **gifts of bread** and wine brought forward by members of the assembly. And beginning this month, **Anointing of the Sick** will again take place during the daily Mass on the 2nd and 4th Fridays of the month. We will still maintain social distancing and require people to wear masks (with the exception of the 11 am Sunday Mass). The latest guidelines (April 28th) from the Archdiocese have given parishes instructions as to what we are able to do now, so you will see additional changes as spring continues. Thank you all so much for your patiences as we have made this journey through the pandemic together.
