

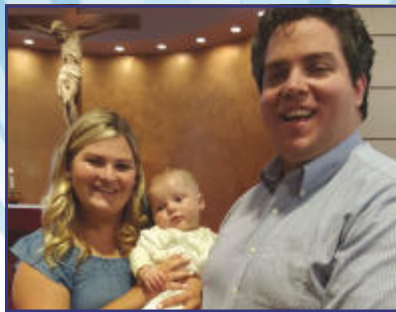

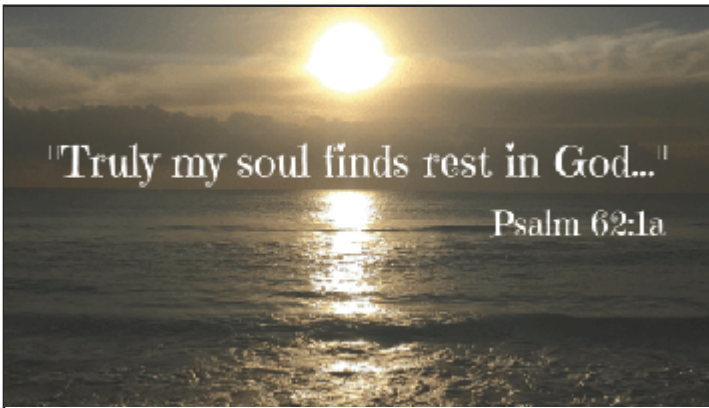

Reflection questions for Sunday, July 25th



THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION
SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

There's an ordinary pine grove located on a tree farm not too far from town where life's stresses and demands seem to melt away. It is here that all that seemed so important out there no longer is and one can get lost in the rows of trees and majestic beauty. God is here and all is good. We need to connect with the Divine Source of all that is in order to understand what it is we are doing and why we are doing it. Otherwise, things stop making sense and bitterness can overcome one's spirit. It's okay to play once in a while and to discover that place of profound life and peace. People always have needs and there is constantly something to do. And while all of that is necessary and we are needed, there is also that inner solitude within that needs to be celebrated and released.

We all need a pine grove. It's that little place we can go and leave all that consumes us behind. It's a place where technology can be set aside and wonder, and awe given some time. We don't have to text, calculate, or orchestrate anything in the pine grove. It is a somewhat deserted place where all of that can be set aside and we can just be. The anger, frustration, exhaustion, discouragement, helplessness, and occasional apathy all can fall to the ground like all of those pine needles that once held their place on the branch of a Frasier Fir. The needles can let go. We can let go. We are beings connected with Being and we all need to remember what really matters, who really matters and what life is truly all about. We need to find that place where we can rest and let go of all of the barnacles we accumulate. Rest, breathe, seek, and love.

The world will need us again when we leave the pine grove. It will all be waiting for us, beckoning for our attention. But we will have prayed and will have marveled at the silence and the beauty of goodness. We can go back, ready, and eager to listen, to help, to heal, to cry, to embrace, and attend to all that is asked of us. But, having let go of the distractions in that deserted place, we will have a renewed sense of purpose. We will know better Who it is we serve and what we are meant to do. It will all be clearer now that we have been Divinely touched and refreshed. ©LPi

Guiding the Next Generation in Their Faith

Have you seen the bulletin board for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd outside the Borromeo Room or walked past the Parish Hall during Mass and wondered what CGS is? It is a Montessori-based, hands-on religious education program for children ranging in age from 3-12 that is being implemented campus-wide at St. Charles, spearheaded by Alicia Van Hecke, Children's Discipleship leader.

Previously featured in our Parish Hall and now located in the heart of our school building, CGS provides a thoughtful and carefully-prepared room known as an atrium in which children can listen to God, talk to God, and learn about God.

Dick Wartman, one of our parishioners and a trained catechist, has been instrumental in helping guide the next generation of parishioners in their faith. Dating back to his college years, Dick began his background in religious education when he helped second grade students prepare for the Sacraments of Holy Communion and Reconciliation. After he and his wife Stephanie relocated to Hartland in 1994, they joined our parish, where Dick continued on as a second and sixth grade catechist.

"When our religious education leadership changed a few years ago, Alicia Van Hecke approached me about Catechesis of the Good Shepherd," Dick says.

After completing training, Dick became one of our CGS leaders and has seen firsthand how incredible the program is for children.

"I quickly realized that CGS was a way for children to experience the liturgy by entering into the mysteries of our faith, which I've enjoyed the most," he says. "CGS allows me to enter into the deepest mysteries through a shared experience with the child, too."



Dick has also noticed spiritual changes in himself as a CGS leader.

"CGS has affected my own spirituality in a powerful way," he says. "There is a profound sense of humility involved as I completely submit and trust in the work of the Holy Spirit rather than myself. Admittedly in the beginning, this was challenging for me as my nature is to take control rather than trust. What I've discovered is that's the complete opposite with children — they become the nourished mustard seeds by completely trusting and embracing the mysteries of our faith with a sense of wonder."

Dick's involvement in CGS has been a fruitful experience, one he cherishes.

"I'm blessed to serve this vocation as it has allowed growth in my own spiritual life by trusting in the Holy Spirit just like the child," he says.
