WALKING WITH GOD'S WORD IN LENT

Can you believe that Lent begins this week? In Advent, we began preparing our minds and hearts to grow closer in relationship with the Person of Jesus Christ. In our final EC NEXTSTEP card, we reflected on how to Meditate on God's Word. This will be our focus for the season of Lent, as well.

In the Bulletin next week, there will be an insert with the Gospel passage for every day in Lent. This page will be perforated, and will allow you to keep that week's card near your Bible (or whatever you read the Word of God with.)

Below is a sample: On Wednesday, March 2nd, you are invited to read this passage from Matthew, and to ask the Lord how He is speaking to you – is there a word or phrase that sticks out, why does it stick out, and what action is it leading you to take to grow deeper in Communion with our Lord? Sit and listen quietly to the moment of God in your life and heart.

With each proceeding day for the next 40 days, you are invited to practice this same offering of your prayer with the Word of God. [SNEAK PEAK]: We will be offering two nights in March where our priests will break open the Scriptures with you and give you time to hear God through them (see page 6 of this bulletin).

HOW TO PRAY WITH SCRIPTURE

Lectio Divina

READ:

- Pray the Gospel slowly for that day and invite God to speak to your heart.

REFLECT:

- Let God reveal a word or phrase that connects to you personally – ask questions to more deeply understand.

RESPOND:

- Thank the Lord for His generosity and *resolve to act* and *trust* according to how God led your prayer.

REST:

- Encounter God in the silence and *listen* to Him tell you how much He loves you!

FAST WITH THE PARISH STAFF IN LENT!

Holy Mother Church asks of Her People specifically during Lent to become aware of how some 'things' have taken a little too high a priority in our lives and invites us to make a sacrifice in order to permit a deeper time and space for God to have His Way in our lives.

Some examples often fall on giving up a particular food for Lent, but I'd also encourage you to ask the question of what other 'things' may be distracting you from giving God a little more time in your day. Maybe it's turning off electronic devices 30 minutes before bed in order to let God speak in the silence? Perhaps you could be waking up 15 minutes earlier every day to pray? Are you available to come to Mass an additional day than Saturday night/Sunday? We pray that you are able to ask the Lord what offering He is gracing you to give in these upcoming 40 days.

We sacrifice with a purpose, otherwise the sacrifice can be in vain – there is an intention we offer paired with the sacrifice so that when it's difficult, that intention pushes us to remain faithful to our offering. As a staff, we are inviting you to join us in offering our Lenten Sacrifice for the needs of our Cornerstone Project as we build the new Church.

For example: as you live out the sacrifice agreed upon by you and the Lord (such as not to have a second helping at any meal) – as you become aware of your desire for the second helping, you pray to God with the intentions of the needs for our new Church. You could ask the Lord to bless the safety of the workers. You could ask God to provide the additional financial support needed in unison with the gratitude for all those who have already offered that support. You could ask God for good weather, that the Church may be built timely. These prayers are prayed as you offer your Lenten sacrifice.

Thank you for your prayerful consideration in joining the Staff at St. Charles with this. We are humbled for you to join us as we grow in deeper trust of all God has done, is doing, and will do with the building of our new Church. All Glory to God!

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS ABOUT LENT & LENTEN PRACTICES

Q. Why do we say that there are forty days of Lent? When you count all the days from Ash Wednesday through Holy Saturday, there are 46.

A. It might be more accurate to say that there is the "forty day fast within Lent." Historically, Lent has varied from a week to three weeks to the present configuration of 46 days. The forty day fast, however, has been more stable. The Sundays of Lent are certainly part of the Time of Lent, but they are not prescribed days of fast and abstinence.

Q. So does that mean that when we give something up for Lent, such as candy, we can have it on Sundays?

A. Apart from the prescribed days of fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and the days of abstinence every Friday of Lent, Catholics have traditionally chosen additional penitential practices for the whole Time of Lent. These practices are disciplinary in nature and often more effective if they are continuous, i.e., kept on Sundays as well. That being said, such practices are not regulated by the Church but by individual conscience.

Q. I understand that all the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat, but I'm not sure what is classified as meat. Does meat include chicken and dairy products?

A. Abstinence laws consider that meat comes only from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs - all of which live on land. Birds are also considered meat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Thus, such foods as chicken broth, consomme, soups cooked or flavored with meat, meat gravies or sauces, as well as seasonings or condiments made from animal fat are technically not forbidden. However, moral theologians have traditionally taught that we should abstain from all animal-derived products (except foods such as gelatin, butter, cheese and eggs, which do not have any meat taste). Fish are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles, (cold-blooded animals) and shellfish are permitted.

Q. I've noticed that restaurants and grocery stores advertise specials on expensive types of fish and seafood on Fridays during Lent. Some of my Catholic friends take advantage of these deals, but somehow I don't feel right treating myself to the lobster special on Fridays during Lent.

A. While fish, lobster, and other shellfish are not considered meat and can be consumed on days of abstinence, indulging in the lavish buffet at your favorite seafood place sort of misses the point. Abstaining from meat and other indulgences during Lent is a penitential practice. On the Fridays of Lent, we remember the sacrifice of Christ on Good Friday and unite ourselves with that sacrifice through abstinence and prayer.

Q. I understand that Catholics ages 18 to 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, but what exactly are the rules for these fasts?

A. Fasting on these days means we can have only one full, meatless meal. Some food can be taken at the other regular meal times if necessary, but combined they should be less than a full meal. Liquids are allowed at any time, but no solid food should be consumed between meals.

Q. Are there exemptions other than for age from the requirement to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday?

A. Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting.
