## 2ND WEEK OF LENT

Dear friends, we are in the thick of our Lenten offering – or at least that’s how I feel. God has done a lot already in challenging me to step out of my comfort zone and be willing to receive the hardships of the desert.

Take a moment and ask yourself what is the desire of your heart? Are you seeking that answer? That is what we do in the desert, we search, confident that God is there, even if we don’t see Him or feel Him. As Jesus, we have been led into this Lenten desert by the Spirit, we are not alone! This week, I hope you are able to walk with God’s Word and hear Him speak hope in the midst of temptation. When all is stripped, and we are confronted with our own weaknesses, it is there that God encounters us – He’s not afraid, so neither shall we!

**“...if they will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead.” ~ Luke 16: 31**

Whom are we listening to? There is a lot of noise constantly vying for our attention, but we have a choice as to whom we listen. As I read the Gospel passage for Thursday, March 17th, I was reminded that we remember St. Patrick, who himself was enslaved by the people of Ireland, of whom later God would call him to serve. In Luke’s Gospel we have a man who is rich according to the world and who is seemingly enslaved to his possessions. As I prayed to the Lord about what ‘things’ I may be enslaved to, I heard the Lord inviting me to allow Him permission to reveal to me the Goodness of Eternity that He is preparing me for! God continued to help me see how with every ‘thing’ I try to use to satisfy myself during the day, He ultimately is the One Who can Save, Redeem, and Purify. He wants me to come to Him in the messiness of the day where I did not receive a co-worker with compassion, or I hurt my mom with the words I said, or I chose to not pray, and to let Him enter my heart in those places of woundedness.

Friends, I rested with the Lord in this place of pain and asked Him to come and heal me of any times when I chose to not listen to God speak through the ordinary, daily, monotonous means of life. It was difficult to rest there because it was clear God needed to cut out from within me some places where I had put other ‘things’ above Him. Luke’s Gospel is traditionally known as attributing Jesus to being a Divine Physician who heals—but to heal means there was first an injury. God is asking me to bring to him my physical and spiritual wounds and begin to hear Him speak Truth – He desires to heal me, to provide for me, to comfort me through all my days. He is a God who keeps His promises, and so I enter into this second week of Lent [and hope you can be bold and do the same], confident that my God and yours will fulfill and meet us in our needs, the place of encounter He has called us to love through.

#### READ:

- Pray the Gospel slowly for that day and invite God to speak to your heart.

#### REFLECT:

- Let God reveal a word or phrase that connects to you personally – ask questions to more deeply understand.

#### RESPOND:

- Thank the Lord for His generosity and resolve to act and trust according to how God led your prayer.

#### REST:

- Encounter God in the silence and listen to Him tell you how much He loves you!

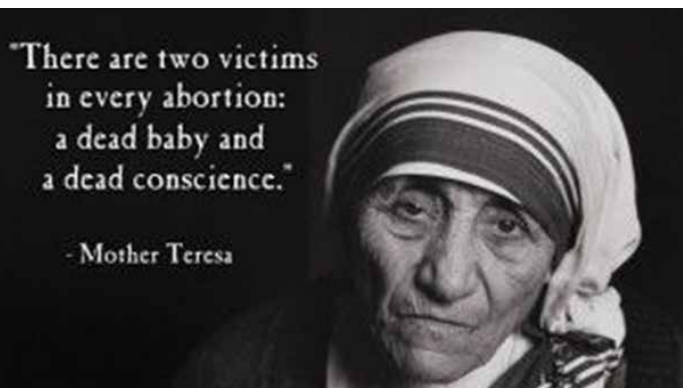

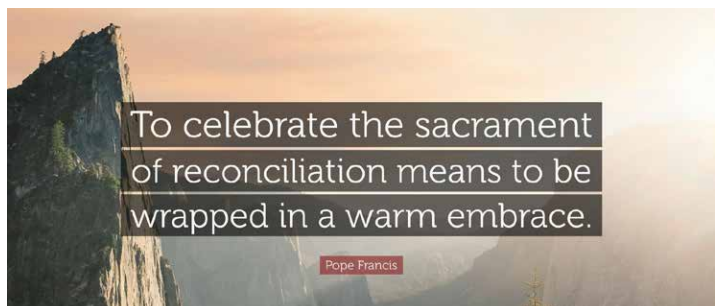
