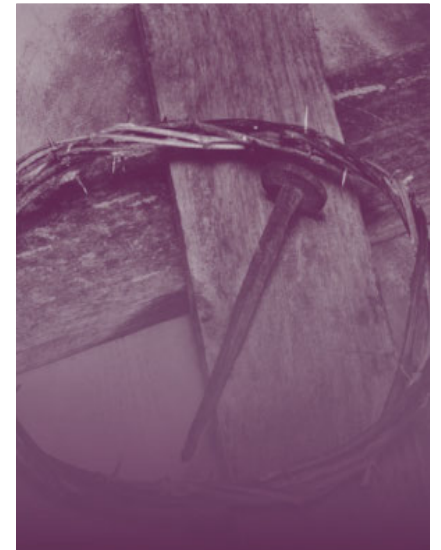

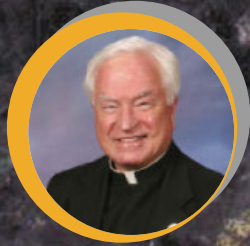

I was helping out at a youth conference last weekend and one of the speakers challenged us by stating that God isn't just looking for friends, He's looking for lovers. Will we continue to fall deeper in love with God as we round the corner of this Lenten season?

Let's take a gut check of our relationship with God, tangibly visible through the lens of our Lenten offerings. When temptations have presented themselves, what has been your response? Now is not the time to beat yourself up for a lack of discipline or a fall that happened. God has never ceased pursuing you to go deeper with Him. The evil one knows exactly where to press on our weaknesses to try to lead us away from the One who Saves. But God created us and will continue to Provide THE Way to holiness and happiness.

Don't doubt His Presence, Hope, Peace, and Joy that He is giving you today! Be honest with where you are at, and recommit right now to strive anew to receive how God is using this Lent for your good and His Glory!

## MAKING ROOM FOR HIS WORD

I started my Lectio Divina reading with a prayer to the Holy Spirit. Two contrasting phrases relating to God's word caught my attention the first time I read this:

"If you remain in my word, you will truly be my disciples."

And

"But you are trying to kill me, because my word has no room among you."

These two phrases at first glance seem to be spoken to two very different groups of people – one much more open to His word and the other much less so. But the reading points to one group of listeners and in reflecting on these verses, I'm inclined to see both of them as applying to me, as well. After all, St. Peter in Matthew 16: 15-23 has a profoundly faithful insight about Jesus and yet, a few verses later, is being compared to Satan and an obstacle.

This is a challenging contrast, to see myself as both a disciple and a pharisee. I wish to "remain in His word" and to be His disciple, and yet, if I'm being perfectly honest, I don't usually make a lot of room for His word.

I respond to this challenge with a question. How can I personally make more room in my heart and my life for Your word? What obstacles get in the way of making room?

The answer is fairly straightforward (if not simple) and twofold.

First, I need to make it more convenient to read God's word every day. I spend a lot of time each day reading on my phone and on my Kindle, but I tend to wait until I can pull out my physical Bible before I read from it. At least until I build up a better habit, I will compromise and allow myself to spend time with His word on one of these devices, even if it isn't in the most aesthetically pleasing format.

Second, I need to take enough time (which doesn't have to be a great deal of time) to make prayerful reading of Scripture my priority instead of making it an item to check off of my to-do list.

I resolve to start with a prayer to the Holy Spirit and take enough time to read, reflect, respond and rest (including some silent time to listen) with God's word.

I recognize that for me, reading God's word is too often an afterthought. I hope that using these devices for God's word will help me make His word a greater priority in my life so that I can remain His word.

**PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION  
APRIL 10TH**

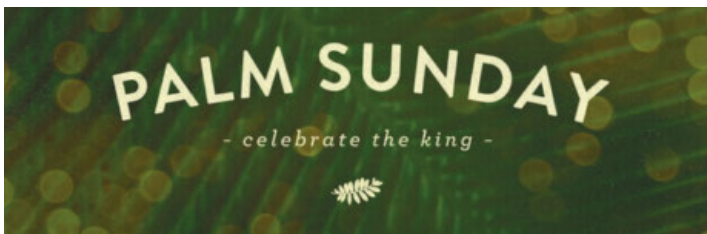
At Palm Sunday Mass, we sing, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" echoing the joyful shouts that welcomed Christ into Jerusalem. Later in the Mass, we recall Christ's suffering and death. No other Sunday in the liturgical year takes us from such an emotional high to the depths of pain and grief. It is the start of Holy Week.

**What will Palm Sunday look like at St. Charles?**

At the 11:00am Mass, all parishioners are invited to gather at the west doors by the gym. Father Nick and Deacon Rob will be wearing red. We will hear the introductory prayers, have our palms blessed, and hear the Processional Gospel. If the weather is good, we will process up the sidewalk and enter through the Borromeo Room. If the weather is less than ideal, we will process through the school. At all other Masses, this action takes place in the back of church, and there is a simple procession. We will wave our palms as the people of Jerusalem did and sing "All Glory, Laud and Honor."

As we enter church, we see that the cross is covered. It will remain covered until Good Friday. The scripture readings draw us into the mystery of Christ's suffering. We pray the beautiful Psalm 22: "My God, My God, Why Have You Abandoned Me?" During the Gospel, we take part in proclaiming the Passion of our Lord. We hear the crowd yell "We want Barabbas!" and "Crucify him!", and we reverently kneel as we hear that Jesus breathed his last. At Offertory, we sing "O Sacred Head" and later the Communion antiphon "Father If This Chalice Cannot Pass." At the end of Mass, we depart in solemn silence.

As we relive this mystery of Christ's suffering and death, there are many feelings to unpack. The Son of God rode into Jerusalem in triumph and is now preparing to die. How will you and your family keep vigil this week? How can you talk with your children about sacrifice, giving, and forgiving? As we enter into this holiest of weeks, may our participation in each liturgy draw us deeper into union with Christ and with one another.

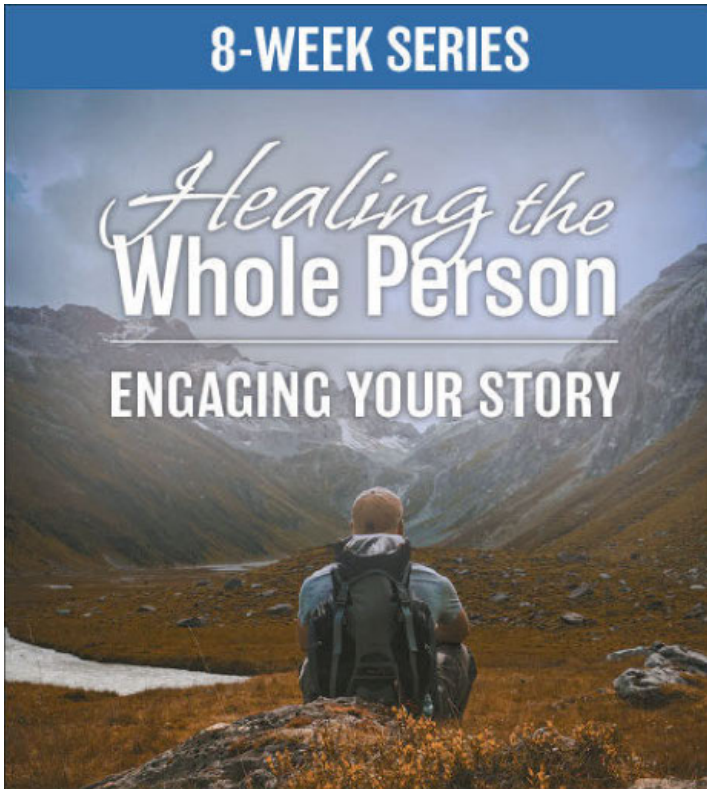
