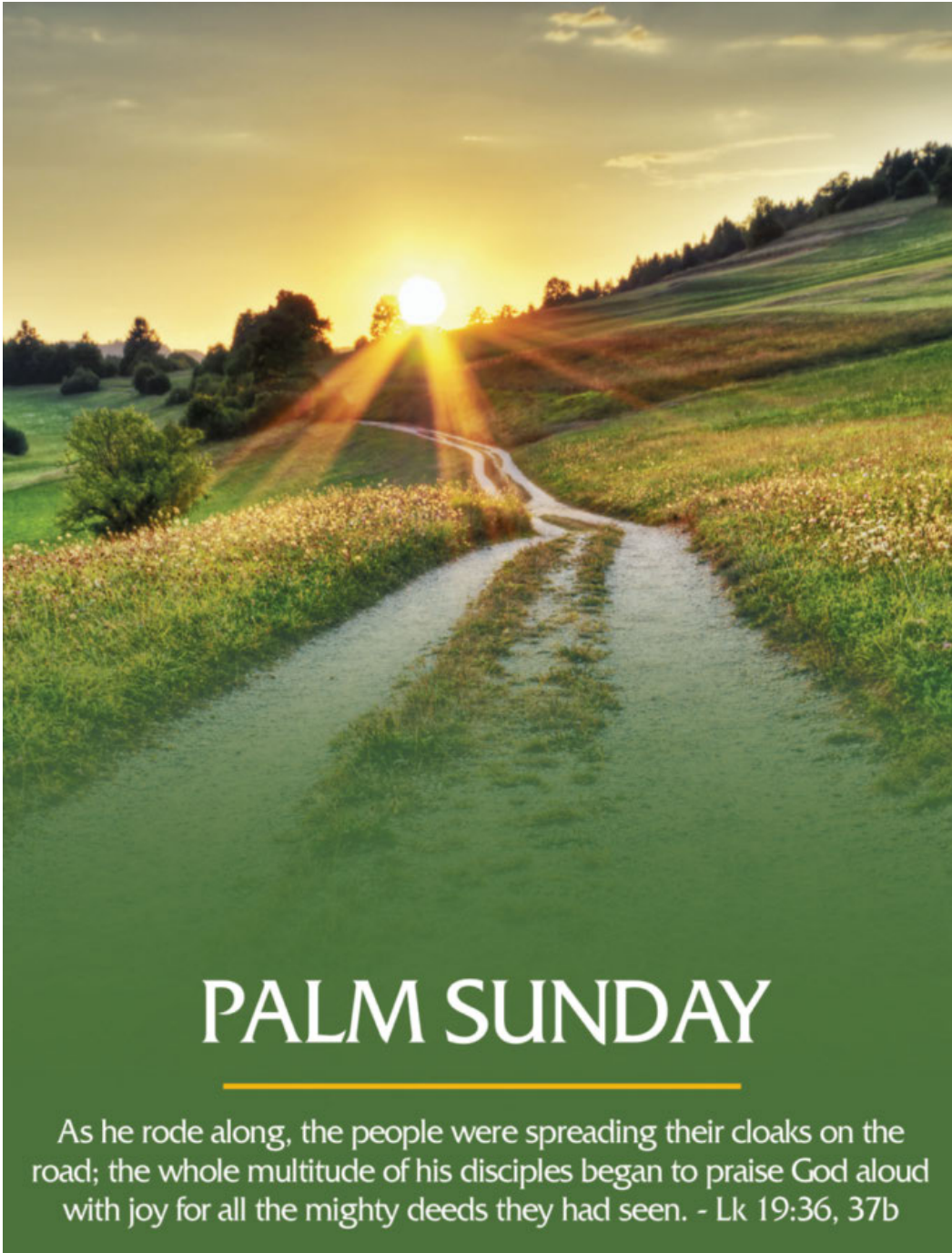

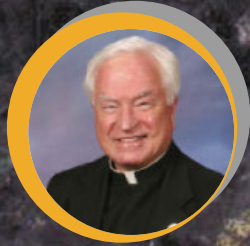

### “Forgiveness and Surrender”

As I was reading, reflecting, responding, and resting over the Gospel reading for Palm Sunday, Luke 19: 28-40, there were two words that were resonating with me, forgiveness and surrender. I think that these are two of the hardest actions for us as humans to do. I know that they are for me, but yet I know that I must be able to do both in order for Jesus and me to have a truly honest, loving relationship. Look at how Jesus did both for us; He forgave all the people who praised Him as King on Palm Sunday, then turned around and accused Him of being a criminal, and finally persecuted Him. The anguish that Jesus must have felt but He was still able to surrender everything up to God. Jesus knew it was God's ultimate plan, not His. Jesus let God use Him as a vessel to save the whole world.

During Lent, have we been looking at ourselves and areas of how we can forgive and surrender? Are there people who have wounded us so badly we avoid them? Have we hurt others by what we say or by our actions? Is there one thing that Jesus has been showing us during our Lenten journey that we need to work on? For true transformation, we must allow Jesus to come into our hearts to bring us His truth and love. We must be able to forgive and surrender completely. If we could do both actions and let God use us as vessels for His plan for us, just imagine the amazing possibilities that are waiting for us. Remember all that Jesus did for us and ask Jesus to help us remain faithful to Him. Jesus, I Trust in You!

#### REST:

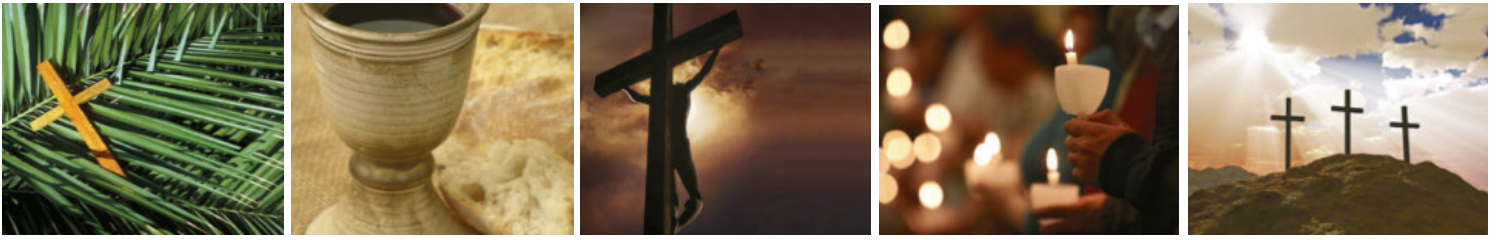
- Encounter God in the silence and listen to Him tell you how much He loves you!

## CELEBRATING HOLY WEEK



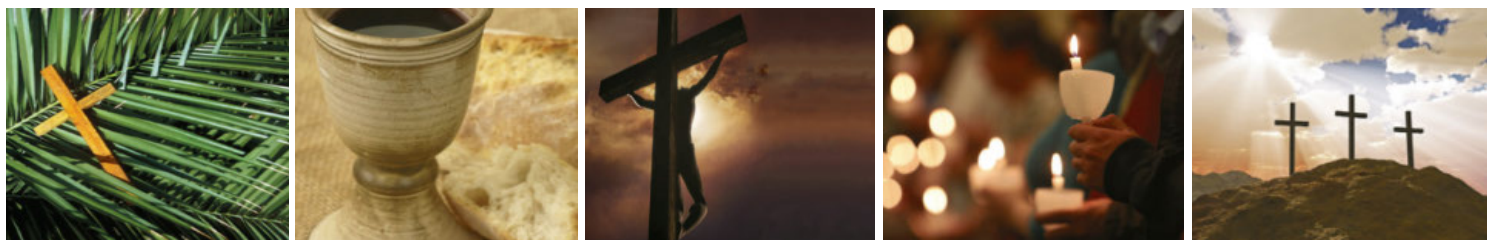
### CELEBRATING HOLY WEEK AT ST. CHARLES

We begin the observance of Holy Week on Palm Sunday, and it leads us into the celebration of the Paschal Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. This most sacred week of the church year is one in which we are drawn ever-deeper into the mission of Christ on earth and eventually His passion, death, and resurrection. The days between Palm Sunday and Holy Thursday (Maundy Thursday) are known as Holy Monday, Holy Tuesday, and Holy Wednesday (Spy Wednesday). Spy Wednesday is called this because of the Gospel reading (Matthew 26:14-25) where we learn that Judas, one of Jesus' disciples, had become a spy and betrayed Him. After this comes the Triduum, which is seen as one continuous liturgy running from Thursday through Saturday.

Part of St. Charles' rich tradition of worship is Daily Mass and Morning Prayer. During the Triduum, however, there can only be two Masses: one on Holy Thursday and one on Holy Saturday. So instead of Daily Mass on these days, we observe Morning Prayer. During Morning Prayer, we sing multiple Canticles and Psalms and hear sacred scripture then a brief reflection given by a member of the St. Charles community. This year the music will be led by Dr. Aaron Mathews and cantor Maria Notch. It is a beautiful opportunity for our priests and deacons to pray as part of the assembly and to be fed by the preaching of a parishioner.

There are many beautiful and rich traditions of Holy Week, including the Palm Sunday Procession, the return of the rice bowls, the reception of the Holy Oils, the footwashing, the collection for the Holy Land, Stations of the Cross, Adoration of the Cross, Adoration of the Eucharist, the Easter Fire, and the blessing of food for our Easter tables. Through the Scripture readings we hear during Holy Week, we once again experience the history of our salvation as the People of God, from the creation of the world by God through his Son's passion, death and resurrection. And music! So much beautiful music that helps us experience the jubilation, pain, suffering, grief, and then eventually a return to joy! We as Christians believe that Holy Week is truly the holiest week of the liturgical year, and the days of the Triduum are the holiest three days, each one greater than the day before. If you have never experienced Triduum, I invite you to come to all three services. Catholics have been doing this for hundreds of years and coming away renewed and affirmed in their faith in Christ, as well as in the beauty of the Church's traditions, prayers and symbolism.

## CELEBRATING THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM



### THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM AT ST. CHARLES

Many Catholics have never experienced the Paschal Triduum in its entirety. **The Triduum is one continuous Rite, consisting of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday when we celebrate the Easter Vigil.** Each of the three days of the Triduum is rich with sacred scripture, powerful rituals, and beautiful music.

### GOOD FRIDAY AT ST. CHARLES

On Good Friday, we gather at 1:00 pm in silence. Baskets will be available in the narthex for the collection for the Holy Land. Good Friday is not a Mass, and it is not a Holy Day of Obligation. The observance begins with a silent procession, and the ministers prostrate themselves in front of the altar. Then, in the Liturgy of the Word, we hear the psalmist lead Psalm 31: "Father into your hands, I commend my spirit." We proclaim the Passion reading. We sing the Solemn Intercessions, and then the cross, which has been covered, is unveiled. We then have the opportunity to adore and reverence the cross. This year we will do so by genuflecting or bowing. During the adoration of the cross, we sing "O Sacred Head," "Were You There," "Behold the Wood," and "Jesus Remember Me." Holy Communion, which was reserved from the previous night's Mass of the Lord's Supper, is distributed. All are invited to participate in Stations of the Cross that evening at 7:00 pm.

### HOLY THURSDAY AT ST. CHARLES

The Triduum begins on Holy Thursday, April 14 at 7:00 pm. After the Gathering Song, we experience the Reception of Holy Oils, which were consecrated on Holy Tuesday by Archbishop ListECKI at the Chrism Mass. First is the Oil of the Sick for healing in body, mind, and soul. Next is the Oil of Catechumens for anointing those preparing for Baptism. Lastly, the Oil of Chrism, which is used to anoint babies after Baptism, those who are being confirmed, Bishops and Priests at Ordination, and altars and churches when they are dedicated. In the Gospel, we hear the story of Jesus sharing a Passover meal with his disciples but first tenderly washing their feet. During our Mass of the Lord's Supper, twelve members of the St. Charles community will have their feet washed by our priests and deacon. Music selections include "Glory in the Cross," "Ubi Caritas," and "What Wondrous Love." At the end of Mass, there is a procession to take the Blessed Sacrament to the chapel. We will sing Pange Lingua, and all are invited to adore the Blessed Sacrament in the chapel until midnight. Lastly, the entire sanctuary is stripped, and the crosses are removed from church.

### HOLY SATURDAY AT ST. CHARLES

On Holy Saturday, there is a blessing of the Easter foods at 4:00 pm in church. At 8:00 pm, we gather outside in the northeast parking lot for the Easter Fire. The Easter Vigil is the high point and holiest day of the entire church year. The church begins in darkness, and the Exultet will be chanted by Father Nick. The Paschal Candle is lit, and from that one light of Christ, we too light our taper candles until the entire church shines with the light of Christ. In the Liturgy of the Word, we hear the story of our faith from Genesis to the Resurrection: nine scripture readings and eight psalms. Music will be led by the Adult Choir accompanied by a brass quartet, under the direction of Dr. Aaron Mathews. There will be a Sprinkling Rite, to remind us all of our own Baptism, and our call to live that out in our daily lives. Our joyous music tells the story of resurrection, as we are finally able to proclaim "Alleluia! Christ is risen!"

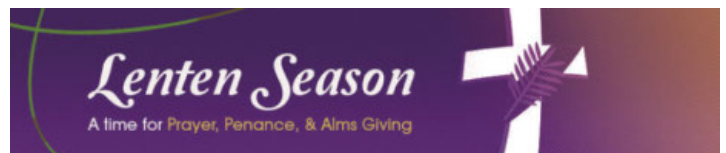
