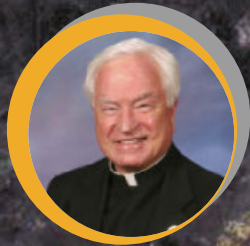

**CHRIST IS RISEN! HE IS RISEN INDEED!**

Alleluia!!! Dear friends, rejoice today, no matter how your Lent was or where you are at right now in your relationship with God. He died and rose for you! Believe that truth because He doesn't want you to remain anywhere else than in the freedom given through His Passion, Death, and Resurrection!

Did you know that we remember the Paschal Mystery (Jesus' Passion [Suffering], Death, and Resurrection) at EVERY Mass we attend? So when you find yourself in any place of doubt, anxiety, anger, etc...rise up from the tomb that has held you in darkness because His death conquered death forever!

Lent reminded me how there will still be acts of suffering that we will be asked to suffer with Him, but we have the confidence that He has redeemed it even though we have not gone through it yet. REJOICE today for we are renewed by the death and life of our Savior, Jesus Christ!!!

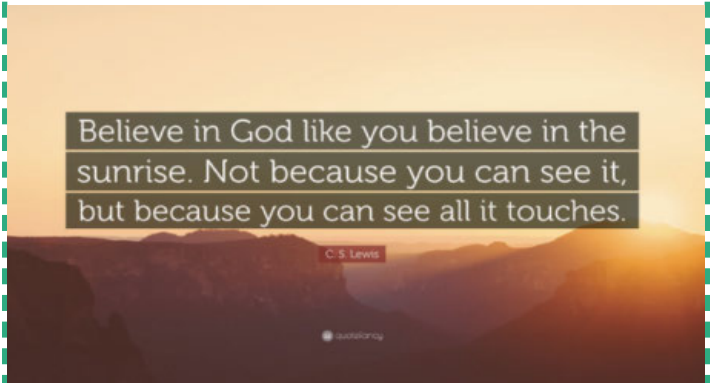
— Reflection questions for EASTER Sunday, April 17th —

- We hear in the reading from Acts some of the earliest proclamations from Peter about his witness to the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. To whom in your life should you bear witness to the resurrected Christ?
- Using the image of unleavened bread, Paul urges the believers in Corinth to see the resurrection of Jesus as an opportunity to start anew. What needs renewal in your life?
- The apostles did not initially believe the witness of Mary Magdalene and the other women to news of the resurrection of Jesus. Why do you think so many people today still doubt this good news?



15 minutes each day spent in God's presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

— Reflection questions for Sunday, April 24th —



- Luke tells us of the success and healing power of the apostles in the Jerusalem church in the early days, weeks, and months following Jesus' resurrection. Where do you see this level of enthusiasm for the faith today?
- The resurrected Jesus appears to John on the island of Patmos during his exile for bearing witness to the faith. In this encounter, John is initially fearful but then reassured by Jesus. When have you turned to Jesus in moments of fear in your life?
- The apostle Thomas challenges his fellow apostles about the reality of Jesus' resurrection, seeking direct evidence from Jesus himself. How often do you encounter fellow believers who are skeptical in their faith?

## EASTER SEASON

### He is Risen! Alleluia!!!

We have journeyed together through the forty days of Lent. We have worn purple, prayed, fasted, and given alms as we focused our hearts ever more keenly on Christ. Our music and our lives have been more sparing as we prepared our hearts for the great celebration of the Triduum and Easter Sunday.

Easter begins with the Easter Vigil celebration on Saturday April 16 at 8:00pm. We then celebrate our regular schedule of Sunday morning Masses at 7:00 am, 9:00 am (with Children's Choirs, Adult Choir, and Brass,) and the 11:00 am Mass. There is no 6:00 pm Mass on Easter Sunday. In order to help us celebrate lavishly and well, incense will be used at the Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday at the 9:00 am and 11:00 am Masses.

Easter Sunday is the start of the Easter Season, which lasts for fifty days, culminating in the Feast of Pentecost. During the Easter Season, the entire character of our worship changes. Our music becomes brighter and more jubilant. The Handbell Choir comes back, and we hear a brass ensemble at the Vigil and Easter 9:00 am Mass.

During the Easter Season, we sometimes celebrate a Sprinkling Rite during Mass, which helps us recall our own baptism and reminds us of our call to discipleship. This year, we have chosen a new "Springs of Water" setting that is joyful and singable in order to facilitate active participation by the assembly. If we are lucky, we will have the honor of witnessing a baby or young child being welcomed into the faith by celebrating baptism during a weekend Mass. We as the Body of Christ experience the joy of receiving the newest of Christians and vow to support them in their faith journey. St. Charles is blessed with so many young families, and we are honored to accompany them on their faith journey.

Finally, we can proclaim once again the joyous refrain of "Alleluia." "Alleluia" comes from the ancient Hebrew meaning, "Praise the Lord!" It is used in the Mass as a superlative expression of thanksgiving, joy, and triumph since Christ has conquered death. We sing "Jesus Christ is Risen Today" with its chorus of Alleluias. We proclaim the Gospel Acclamation, which uses Alleluia as the refrain and then a verse that summarizes the main idea of the upcoming Gospel reading. Lastly, we are dismissed at the end of the Mass with the priest or deacon chanting: "Go in the peace of Christ, Alleluia, Alleluia!" To which we respond, "Thanks be to God, Alleluia, Alleluia!" This ancient chant ties us to our rich tradition and history as Catholics and reminds us every week of Christ's resurrection and triumph over death. He is risen: Alleluia!



## DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY APRIL 24TH

### What is Divine Mercy Sunday?

Since the year 2000, the Second Sunday of Easter is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. This celebration finds its roots in the private revelations of a Polish nun, Faustina Kowalska, who lived in the early part of the twentieth century.

Sr. Faustina, though poorly educated, kept a diary during her short lifetime in which she documented her experiences of visions and conversations with Jesus. In her diary, Sr. Faustina wrote that she experienced an image of the Risen Lord, from whose heart two rays shone, one red (representing blood) and the other white or translucent (symbolizing water) with the words "Jesus, I trust in you" at the bottom. Sr. Faustina claimed that Jesus told her, "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish."

The Image of Divine Mercy is very familiar to Catholics. It symbolizes God's abundant mercy. Sr. Faustina's diary stresses the importance of God's mercy, and our need to be open and accepting of that mercy. According to Sr. Faustina, it was Jesus' own wish that a Feast of Mercy be established on the Second Sunday of Easter, to "be a refuge and shelter for all souls ..."

Sr. Faustina died in 1938 and was canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2000. It was John Paul II who proclaimed during her canonization ceremony that the Second Sunday of Easter would also be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

Devotion to the Divine Mercy has grown rapidly over the past twenty years, and there are many devotional practices including a novena, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, the Hour of Great Mercy (traditionally celebrated at 3 p.m.), and a plenary indulgence granted to those who receive the Eucharist and celebrate reconciliation on Divine Mercy Sunday.

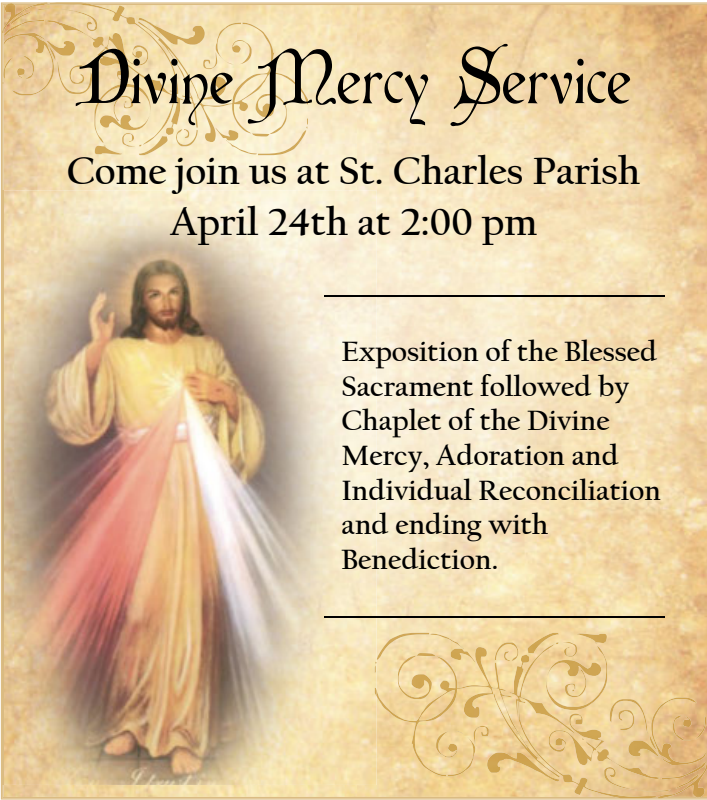
Here at St. Charles, the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy is prayed every Friday at 3:00 p.m. in the Chapel at the end of Eucharistic Adoration. On Sunday, April 24th, there will be a Divine Mercy Service from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. This service will include Eucharistic Adoration, veneration of the Image of Divine Mercy, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, and the opportunity for individual confession. All are welcome to come and pray with us.

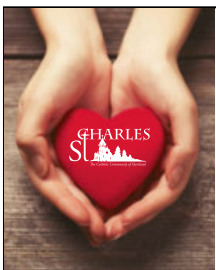

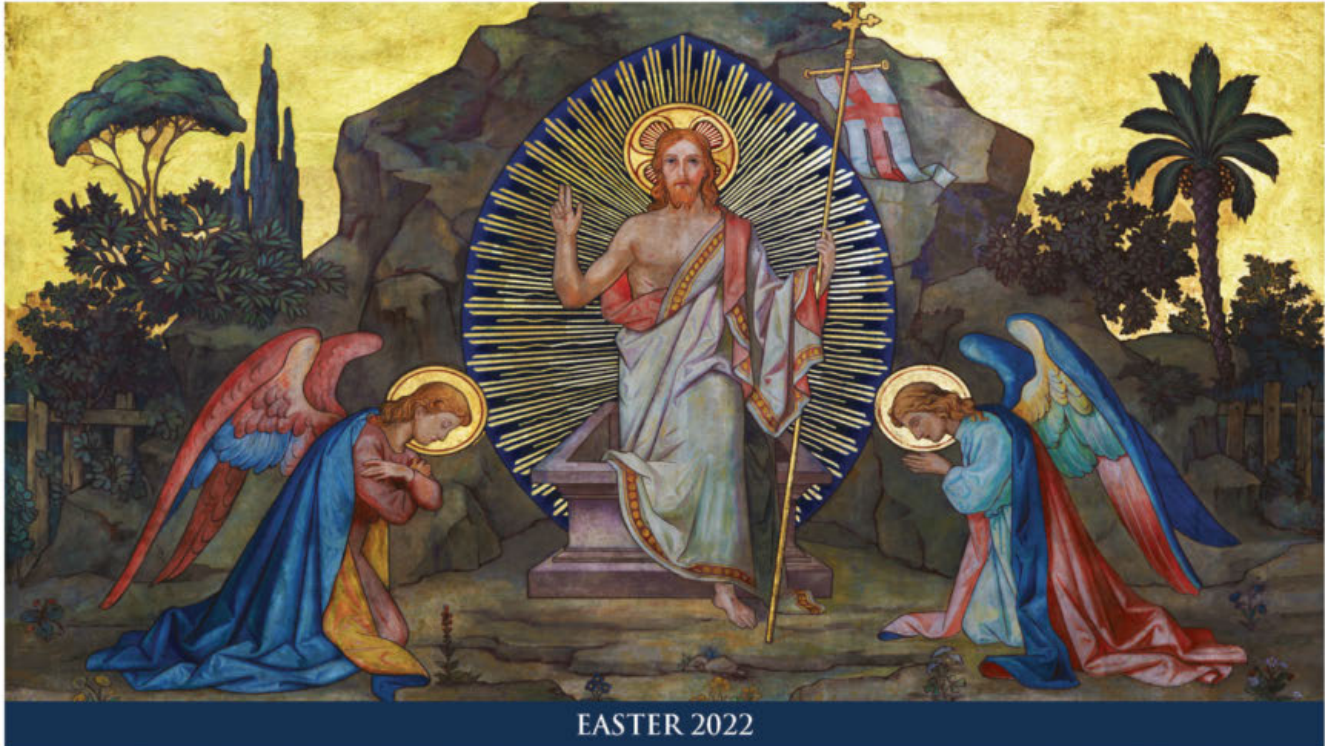

*Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ!
