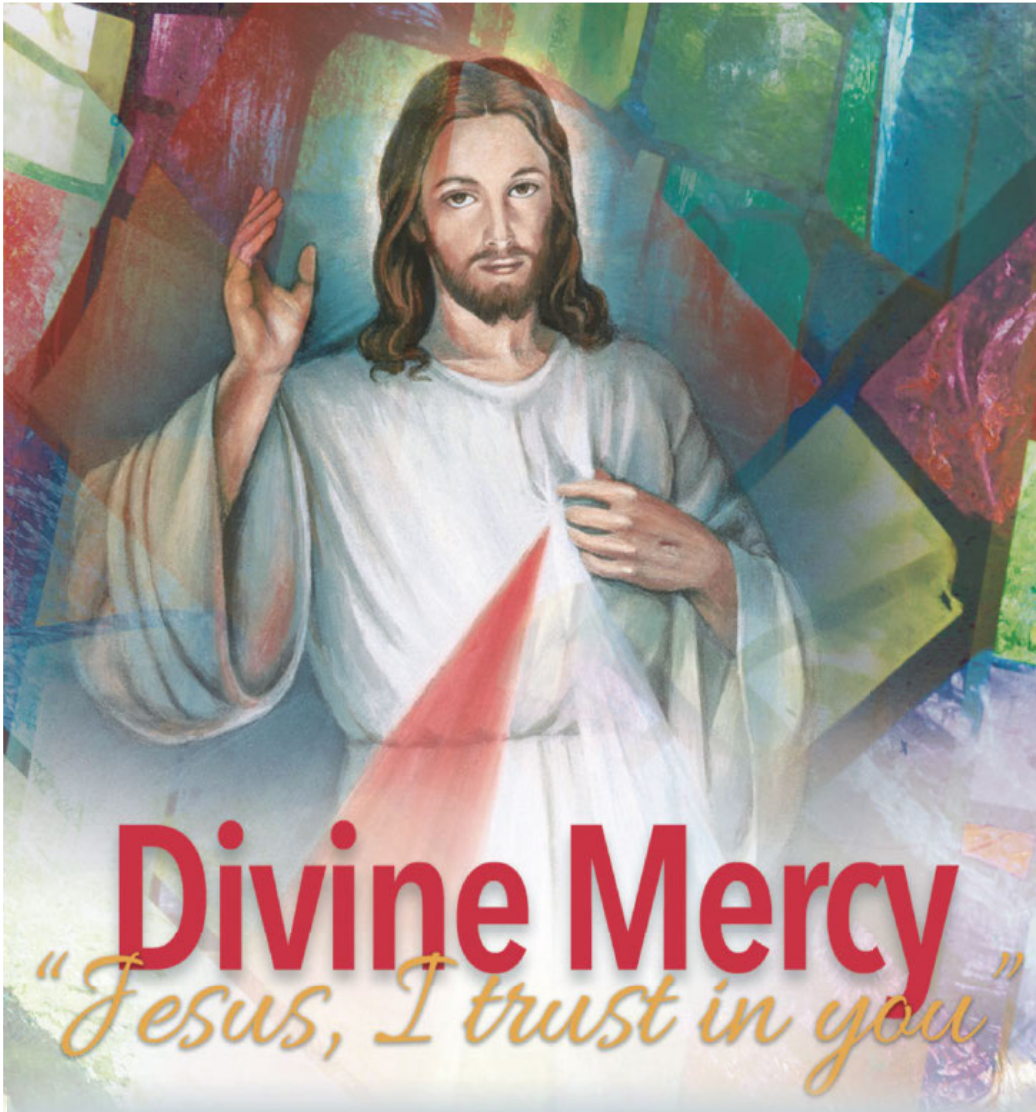

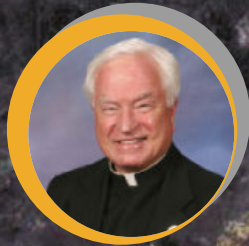

THE OCTAVE OF EASTER!

Happy Easter! For the past eight days in the Church, we have been celebrating Easter Sunday. What? I know! The Octave of Easter as it is called in the Church invites us to celebrate as a Solemnity the Resurrection of Jesus – Easter Sunday – for eight days!

If you haven't already, reflect on this past week. How has life been different outside the discipline of Lent? Did some of the sacrifices you offered remain even after the Season of Lent ended? The invitation of our sacrifices and additional prayer is not for it to end when Lent concludes but for these to change us and hopefully to remain to some varying degree as a resolution to be practiced and lived. CELEBRATE! If you have been able to come or livestream our daily Masses, we have sung the Gloria every day – a sign that the Church elevates these eight days with highest honor! Follow suit and rejoice even as today the Church recalls the gift of God's Divine Mercy! The rays from Jesus' pierced Heart remind us of the Blood and Water poured out of love for you – yes, YOU! Receive from His Heart the joy, peace, and healing that comes from His Resurrection, His new life: "We are an Easter people, and Alleluia is our song!"

My hope for you is two-fold. Try to spend a solid 7 minutes daily with our Lord and just let Him speak into your heart the truth of who you are (a beloved son or daughter) and who He is (a Good Father who is in love with you)! This allows us the time to recall your Baptism that was recalled on Easter Sunday. Then out of these truths, go and be Christ to those He puts in your path! Do not be afraid, He has provided the Grace by His Death and Resurrection, and we partake in His Spirit!



15 minutes each day spent in God's presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

Reflection questions for Sunday, May 1st



- The apostles faced trial and even persecution from the religious leaders of Jerusalem (the Sanhedrin) for bearing witness to Jesus' resurrection. Why do you think some people are threatened by the good news of Jesus risen from the dead?
- John sees a vision of heaven in which all of the created order is worshipping Jesus as the slain and risen "Lamb." What images of heaven bring you comfort?
- The resurrected Jesus appeared to seven of his disciples while they were fishing on the Sea of Tiberias. In doing so, Jesus comes to strengthen Peter for his upcoming leadership role. What gives you strength in your faith journey?

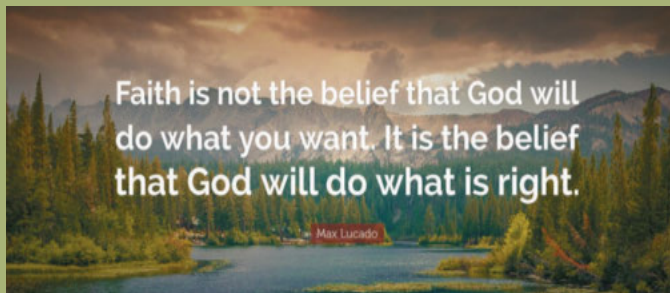

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Life is about to get very interesting for the disciples. Finding themselves questioning what happened to Jesus and whether he actually was raised from the dead,



they are afraid and uncertain. In the midst of this fear, questioning, and uncertainty, Jesus decides to surprise them with a visit! This visit, complete with the gift of peace, fills the disciples with great excitement and joy. But their detailed testimony is not enough to convince their absent friend Thomas. He wants to see for himself. We struggle with belief, as well. It is hard for some to give themselves over to the testimony of another. We want to see the resurrected Christ in person. God, through the gift of eyes of faith, gives us the ability to do precisely that: when we witness the healing that comes from forgiveness, the beauty that flows from love, the wonder of creation, the new life that comes after we fall, and the unique soul that lives behind each person's life. Christ is risen. Life will get very interesting for us, too, when we stop disbelieving and believe!

THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

2ND SUNDAY OF EASTER (DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY)

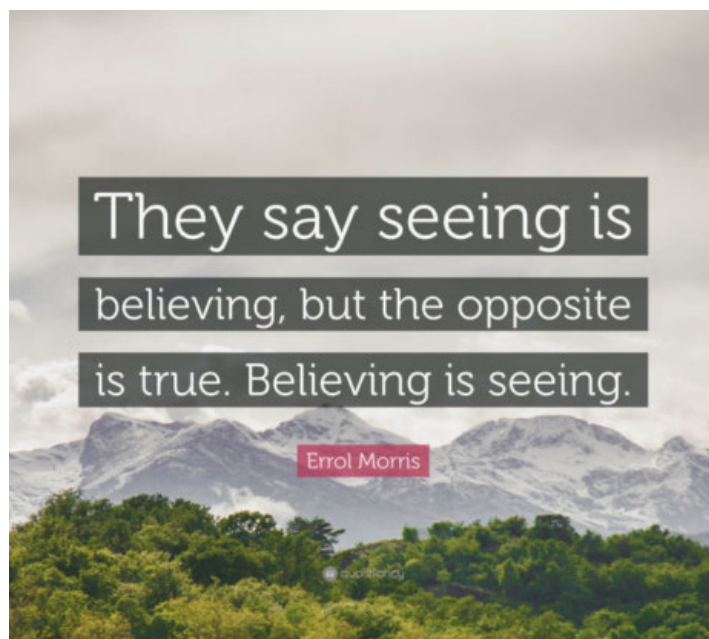
Even Thomas struggles to remove his boulder! Being very pragmatic and determined, he wants to see the risen Christ for himself! Thomas's boulder is heavy with mistrust. Many of ours are, too. A certain amount of skepticism is good as it can save us from being duped or misled. But we can become so skeptical of things that it erodes our ability to trust anything we see or hear. Skepticism can actually be a well-disguised defense mechanism that we use to prevent us from being hurt or perceived as a fool. Having too much ego protection is a real risk. Thomas, because of the boulder blocking his vision, could not even trust the word of his friends.

Boulders are hard to move. It's difficult to seek change or take a risk, especially when we are so afraid to be vulnerable or reluctant to trust another's word. When we are closed minded, overly pragmatic, unwilling to see things in a different way, stubborn or defensive, it is difficult to be surprised by God and stretched. We need to be less guarded, self-assured, and self-absorbed. God cannot break into the ordinary moments of our lives and inspire us when we cling to doubt. If we are going to discover resurrection faith, we have to believe that what the witnesses say is true, especially when they are credible. We also have to trust that the risen Christ is alive in us, too!

While the first witnesses to the resurrection have faded into history, there are many others who have come after them. They continue to inspire by walking the talk of faith. They are the martyrs who offer their lives for the Gospel, the

simple holy people in our communities who cling so steadfastly to their faith, those who have touched despair and found new hope and the ones who, even in spite of ridicule, still pursue their hunger and thirst for God. They are our friends, acquaintances, biblical heroes, and saints, and many others who are convinced that they have seen the Lord! The risen Christ may not surprise us with the same kind of visit as he did the first disciples, but God finds other ways. All we have to do is open our eyes, remove whatever is preventing us from seeing and believing and exclaim: "My Lord and my God!"

Grieving with Great HOPE

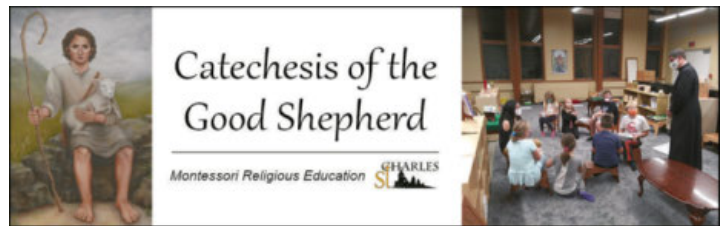
FIVE-WEEK GRIEF SUPPORT WORKSHOP AT ST. CHARLES

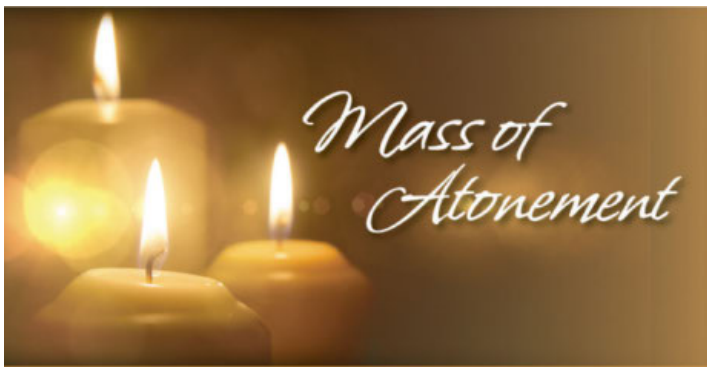
