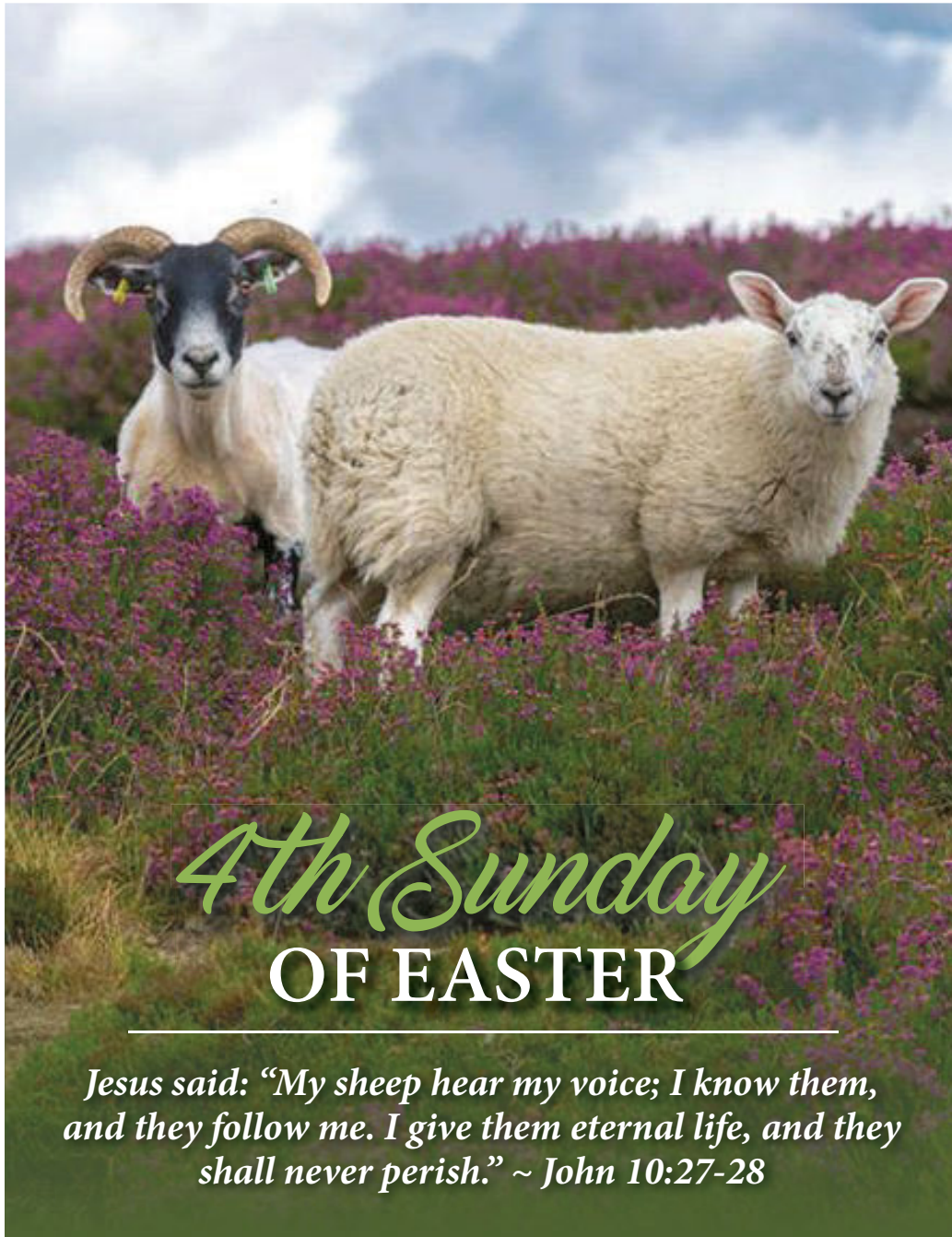

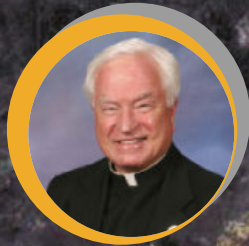

I WAS A WHALE!

When asked to write this piece on how the sacrament of Reconciliation has affected me, I was a tad surprised. I mean, in all honesty, it was not that long ago that I had “reconnected” with this very sacrament. In fact, the date was March 30th, 2019 at the Men of Christ Conference at Miller Theater in Milwaukee. I was attending my first conference and enjoying all the speakers, camaraderie, and fellowship that the conference offers, but then came the moment. I sat down in a large conference room with 80 fellow attendees and sat across from a priest for my first reconciliation in over 20 years.

On my way downtown that morning, I committed to divulging everything, I mean absolutely everything I needed forgiveness for. In between everything, I wanted to say I kept thinking “just keep it simple,” “keep it quick,” and “don't go there...”. So, I sat down and decided to engage Father. He asked when was the last time I went to confession, and I said “over 20 years ago, Father, I'm sorry.” Then the priest did something that made me extremely comfortable. He said, “well, you're my favorite kind...a whale. A whale is someone who hasn't sought forgiveness in the sacrament of reconciliation for quite some time and could be here for a while.” After a quick laugh, we got started.

To me, Reconciliation has become more than just me asking for forgiveness for the prior week's sins, doing penance, and moving on. Through our Lord's unconditional grace, I've learned to be more forgiving of others in my daily interactions. If the Lord forgives me, a continual sinner, how can I harbor ill will toward even my harshest critics? My relationships have grown as a result. Reconciliation has also given me the gift of walking lighter on this earth. Not carrying the weight of guilt and embarrassment on a daily basis has been one of the deepest and greatest gifts I've received from our Lord.

It's not easy being a whale. I know, I was one. I would encourage anyone who hasn't connected with our Lord via the sacrament of Reconciliation to commit to it soon. Our parish is blessed with two unbelievable priests who have helped me navigate this holy sacrament and will do the same for you. You deserve it, you deserve God's unconditional love, you deserve a clear mind, and you deserve to let go of the weight of all those sins holding you down. I was a whale, I went, and I'm so incredibly happy that I did.



15 minutes each day spent in God's presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

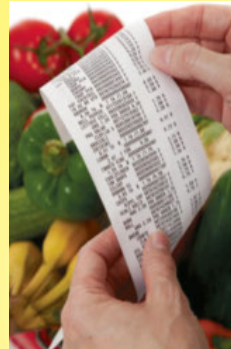

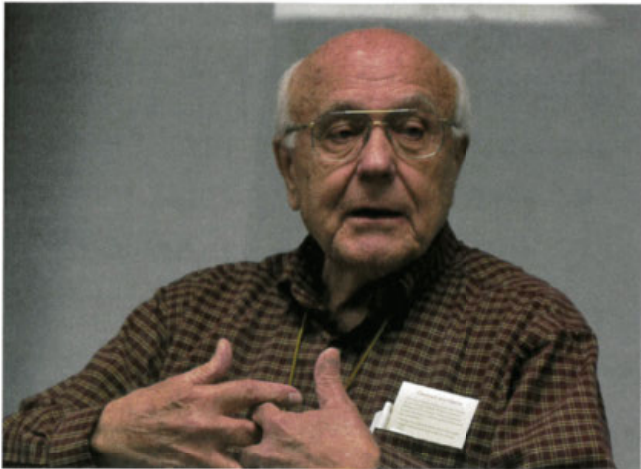


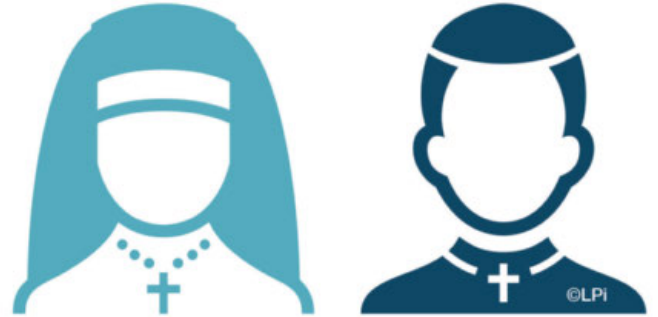

Father Frank Ruff to be honored

AWARENESS / Longtime ecumenist awarded for successful career

Glenmary Father Frank Ruff will receive the annual James E. Fitzgerald Award from the Catholic Association of Diocesan Ecumenical and Interreligious Officers (CADEIO), recognizing his years of commitment to ecumenical ministry. The award will be given during the National Workshop on Christian Unity, May 3-6 in Anaheim, California.

Father Frank's ministry included a focus on ecumenism for more than 50 years before he retired from Glenmary's Ecumenical Commission in 2021. His work focused on improving ties with Southern Baptists, and for many years he was the only Roman Catholic presence at the annual convention of Southern Baptists.
