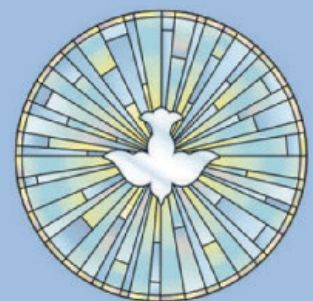

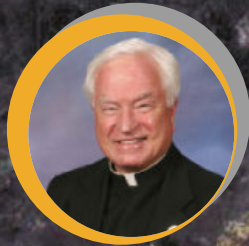

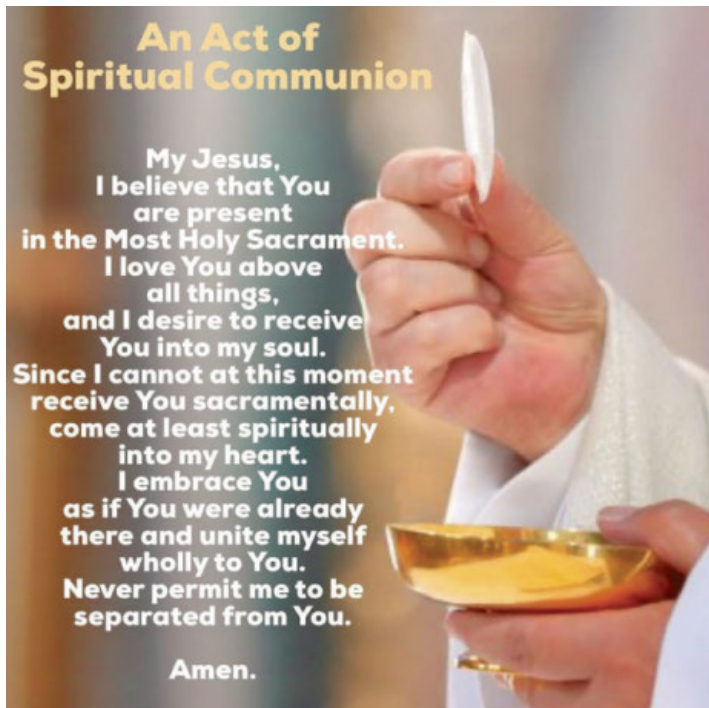
OUR EXPERIENCE OF HEAVEN ON EARTH

AMEN! May we not take this one syllable word for granted. There is meaning in everything we say and do within our faith, but I know I don't always allow my heart to reflect on how that affects my participation and involvement. Reflect on our disposition in receiving Holy Communion. What was on your heart as you were in the pew during the Consecration? Consecration is when Father extends his hands over the bread and wine and with the same words of Jesus, invites the Spirit to change these simple substances into the True Presence of Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. FUN FACT: The theological term for this is transubstantiation.

Brothers and sisters, the Lord has invited me everyday to receive Him in the Eucharist, and I try to never take advantage of this grace to be in communion with God! This Sacrament goes hand in hand with Reconciliation ... in God's utter mercy He forgives us of the wrongs we have done (or the good we have not done) and then permits us to come to Him in our frailty and say AMEN, I believe! I believe that You make all things work for good, that You love me because I am your beloved daughter [or son]!

Holy Mother Church asks for Her children to come and worship once a week, to honor the Sabbath on Saturday evening or Sunday. How is God inviting your family to experience Heaven on Earth beyond this opportunity? Daily Mass is not viable for all families, but together, could you offer a prayer of Spiritual Communion before dinner or at bedtime? This invites God to spiritually come into your heart until the next weekend's Mass when you receive Him physically in Holy Communion. Choose a way that permits God to daily be experienced and then watch as He shows up and performs miracles in the ordinary of your life!



15 minutes each day spent in God's presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!



— Reflection questions for Sunday, May 22nd —

- Today's reading offers an excerpt from the "dissension and debate" taking place at the first Church council in Jerusalem over the question of male circumcision. How often do you experience conflict within your faith community?
- One of John's final visions depicts the heavenly Jerusalem where God's presence is fully known in all its splendor. Why do you think this vision of heaven was revealed to John?
- During his farewell discourse, Jesus reassured the disciples with the promise of the Holy Spirit and the promise of divine peace. When do you experience God's presence this way in your life?

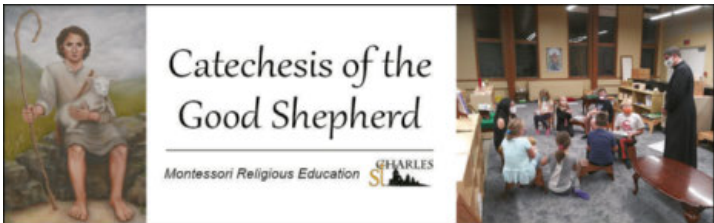

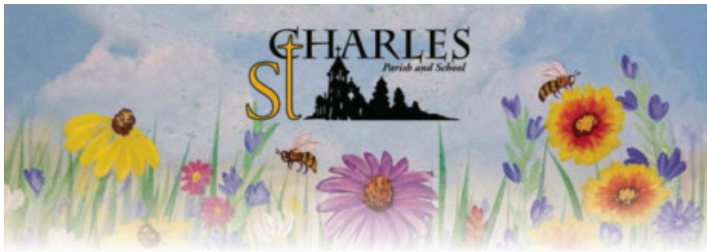
